Hartford. **WADSWORTH ATHENEUM**, 25 Atheneum Square, N, 1842-1844. Granite, stories, rectangular, flat roof with castelated parapet, corner towers, 3-story towers flanking entrance, diamond-paned rectangular and lancet windows with elaborate tracery; renovated and enlarged, 1969. Gothic Revival. Built by Daniel Wadsworth, wealthy philanthropist, who conceived the idea of a fine arts gallery in Hartford. *Private*.
