It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Title 6 of the General Laws entitled "Commercial Law - General
2	Regulatory Provisions" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following chapter:
3	CHAPTER 30.1
4	PROHIBITION OF CREDIT CARD NUMBER DISCLOSURE
5	6-30.1-1. Prohibited disclosure of credit card number. – Any person, firm or
6	corporation who accepts a credit card as defined by section 6-30-2 from a cardholder shall not
7	issue a receipt to that person which lists more than five (5) numbers from the credit card account
8	number.
9	6-30.1-2. Penalty for violation. – Anyone who violates this chapter shall be guilty of a
10	misdemeanor. In addition, any person, firm or corporation which violates this chapter shall be
11	prohibited from maintaining any civil action for the recovery of any debt created through the use
12	of the credit card with the improper receipt.
13	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
