Financial Education recognizes the critical need for the State to have a citizenry that is prepared
to make responsible personal financial decisions; and

participate in a course dedicated to financial literacy each academic year; and

nation do not have an understanding of the core financial concepts that will allow them to make

WHEREAS, School districts and middle and high schools across Rhode Island differ in
the extent that they offer students the opportunity to study personal finance; now, therefore be it

order to develop a statewide strategy, action plan, and marketing plan for increasing middle and
