HOUSE BILL NO. 1241

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-1-35, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT DRIVER'S LICENSE NUMBERS SHALL NOT BE THE LICENSEE'S 3 SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER; TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF LAW REGARDING THE PROTECTION AND 4 5 TREATMENT OF SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 7 SECTION 1. Section 63-1-35, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 8 63-1-35. (1) The Commissioner of Public Safety shall 9 10 prescribe the form of licenses issued pursuant to this article which shall, among other features, include a driver's license 11 12 number assigned by the Department of Public Safety. Such number shall not be the licensee's social security number * * *. 13 14 licensee, except as otherwise provided under subsection (2) of 15 this section, shall list his social security number with the

department which shall cross reference the social security number

with the driver's license number for purposes of identification.

- 19 for the protection and treatment of social security numbers.
- 20 Additionally, each license shall bear a full face color photograph
- 21 of the licensee in such form that the license and the photograph
- 22 cannot be separated. Such photograph shall be taken so that one
- 23 (1) exposure will photograph the applicant and the application
- 24 simultaneously on the same film. The department shall use a
- 25 process in the issuance of a license with a color photograph which
- 26 shall prevent as nearly as possible any alteration,
- 27 counterfeiting, duplication, reproduction, forging or modification
- 28 of such license or the superimposition of a photograph without

- 29 ready detection. Such photograph shall be replaced by the
- 30 department at the time of renewal. Driver's licenses, including
- 31 photographs appearing thereon, may be renewed by electronic means
- 32 according to rules and regulations promulgated by the
- 33 commissioner. The Department of Public Safety may accept bank
- 34 credit cards and debit cards in payment of fees, as defined in
- 35 Section 27-104-33, for driver's license renewals that are
- 36 processed by electronic means and, if authorized by general law,
- 37 may charge an additional fee for the use of such cards.
- 38 (2) The commissioner shall prescribe the form of licenses
- 39 issued pursuant to this article to licensees who are not United
- 40 States citizens and who do not possess a social security number
- 41 issued by the United States government. The licenses of such
- 42 persons shall include a number and/or other identifying features.
- 43 (3) Any new, renewal or duplicate driver's license,
- 44 temporary driving permit, intermediate license or commercial
- 45 driver's license issued to a person required to register as a sex
- 46 offender pursuant to Section 45-33-25 shall bear a designation
- 47 identifying the licensee or permittee as a sex offender.
- 48 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 49 and after July 1, 2008.
