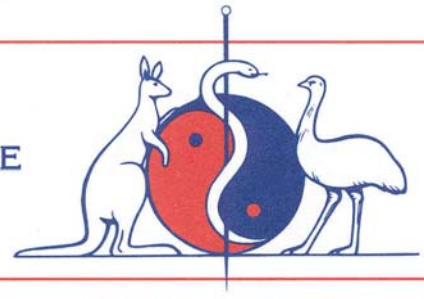

Please share this with us. For example did you know that the chakras correlate with the morphology of the body's growth centres?

Research
