

## CODE OF PLAYER CONDUCT FOR THE 2008 WORLD SERIES OF POKER

- 1. The competitive integrity of all tournament play at the World Series of Poker is paramount. All participants must adhere to the spirit and letter of the official rules of the WSOP which forbid play or any action that is illegal, unethical or constitutes cheating or collusion in any form.
- 2. WSOP tournament officials will penalize any act that, in the sole and absolute discretion of tournament officials, is inconsistent with the rules of the tournament.
- 3. Anyone found to have engaged in or attempted to engage in any act that tournament officials believe in their sole and absolute discretion compromises or could compromise the competitive integrity of the WSOP will be subject to sanctions imposed by tournament officials. The nature and extent of the sanctions imposed shall be in the sole and absolute discretion of tournament officials and may include, but shall not be limited to the following:
  - FORFEITURE OF CHIPS
  - FORFEITURE OF PRIZE MONEY
  - EJECTION FROM THE TOURNAMENT
  - LOSS OF PRIVILEGE TO PARTICIPATE IN FUTURE WSOP EVENTS
  - EXCLUSION FROM ENTERING THE PREMISES OF APPLICABLE HARRAH'S ENTERTAINMENT PROPERTIES.
- 4. Any and all violations of this Code of Player Conduct may be publicly disclosed in an effort to deter future violations and to assist other poker tournaments in identifying players who engage in play that is illegal or unethical or constitutes cheating or collusion in any form.
