Scientist Tells Of Einstein's A-Bomb Regrets

Hollywood, May 13—(AP)—
Dr. Linus Pauling, California
Institute of Technology chem-
ist, says Albert Einstein told
him before he died that he re-
gretted his recommendation
that atom bombs be made.

Dr. Pauling, addressing an
Einstein memorial program au-
dience last night, said he last
saw Einstein last November 16.
He quoted Einstein as saying
then: "I made on great mistake
when I signed the letter to
President Roosevelt recom-
mending that atom bombs be
made."

Pauling added: "Einstein said
there was some justification for
his decision in the danger that
the Germans would make the
bomb first."
