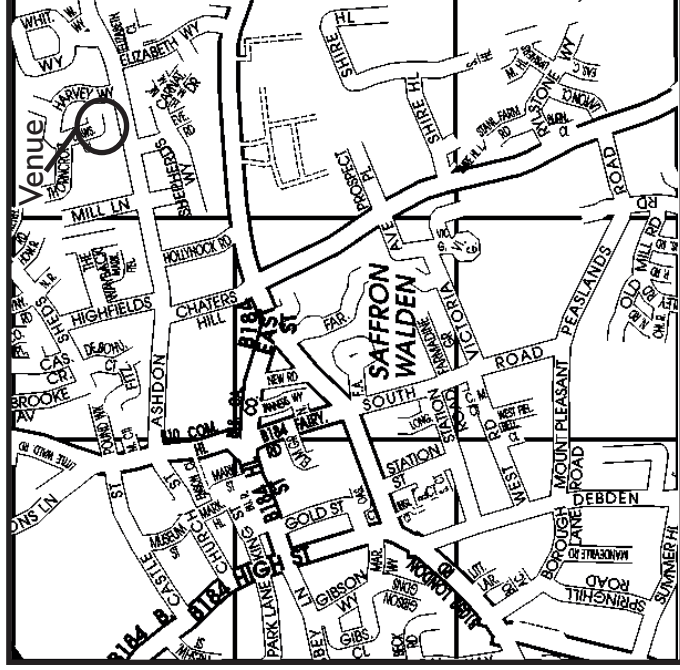

### Route

From the M11, if you are coming from the south take Junction 8 through Stansted and Newport. Turn right into Newport Road then right at the roundabout then straight over at the next roundabout. Go down the High Street as far as the traffic lights and turn right down Hill Street.

If you are coming from the north, take Junction 10 through Great Chesterford. Turn left into Hill Street. Branch left along Common Hill. After the common, turn right into Ashdon Road. The school is on your left after approximately half a mile.

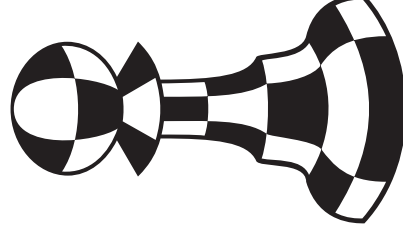

## Late Entries

Entries received after 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2004 will, if accepted, be subject to a £2 surcharge.

## Eligibility

The age cut-off point is 31<sup>st</sup> August 2004. Competitors who wish to do so may enter a section higher than their age group.

## Prizes

First prize in each section will be eight times the entry fee, but sections may be amalgamated or prize money reduced in the event of insufficient entries. Further prize money will depend upon the number of entries received. The prize-giving ceremony will be as soon as possible after the end of the last round.

## Trophies

There will be a trophy for the highest scoring competitor in each section. Tie-breaks will apply as necessary.

## Time Control

30 minutes per player per complete game in every section.

## Bye

A half-point bye may be taken in any one of the first five rounds, provided it is requested at the time of entry.

## Pairings

The Seeded Swiss system will be used in all sections. All competitors play in all rounds except where a bye is requested or forced.

## Arbiter

The Congress will be controlled by qualified arbiter Peter-Walker.

## LJCC Qualification

Players who score 4½ points or more in the Under 12 and Under 10 sections will receive an invitation to the London Junior Championship finals in their respective age group. 3½ points are sufficient for invitation to the London Minor Championship. 4 points are required to qualify for the under 8 final.

*Players who have already qualified for the LJCC are encouraged to play in a higher section than their own age group.*
