Designed to promote Wyoming history and historic sites and to acquaint the public with the resource materials and services available at the Wyoming State Archives, these cards feature photographs of individuals, locations, and artifacts which contributed to or are associated with Wyoming's history and lore. Information about the photo subject is recorded on the back of each card. Each card is individually numbered. The 2002 Premier Edition features two sets, each consisting of twelve different cards.

The price for each set is \$1.50. A shipping and handling charge of \$.40 per set will be assessed for mail orders. Orders may be placed by phone with a credit card.

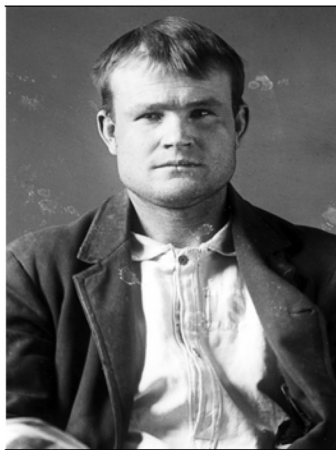
