To help assist with your Motor Coach Parking needs during the Chick-fil-A College Kickoff game on August 30th, 2008 the Georgia Dome is offering pre-paid motor coach parking in the yellow lot on the campus of the Georgia Dome. The lot will be available beginning Friday, August 29th through Sunday, August 31st. The cost is \$70 per RV and \$30 for a tow-vehicle. The lot will open at 6am on August 29th.

Reservations will be accepted beginning on June 30th. The deadline to submit your reservation is July 25, 2008. Please give your email address if you would like a confirmation. Once the lot is sold out you will be contacted. Passes will be sent out beginning August 1st.

1. Reservations guarantee you a space in the yellow lot but do not guarantee a specific spot. You will be instructed by parking personnel on where to park. Failure to obey parking instructions may result in your parking pass being revoked.
2. RV must be present with the parking pass
3. No blocking or reserving of other space.
4. There are no electrical hook-ups or waste facilities
5. Security is provided 24 hours per day
