Fares

Local bus fare is **\$2** (Senior-Disabled fare is \$1.00).

Express bus fare is **\$5** (Senior-Disabled fare is \$2.50).

MetroCard® - Pay-Per-Ride and 7-Day Express Bus Plus MetroCard are accepted on all MTA buses (local, Limited-Stop and express) and on the subway. Unlimited Ride MetroCard (both 7-Day and 30-Day) are accepted on all but express buses. All buses accept exact fare in coins, but not pennies or half dollars.

Free Transfers - Unlimited-Ride-MetroCard permits free transfers to all but express buses. Pay-Per-Ride MetroCard allows one free transfer of equal or lesser value (between subway and local bus and local bus to local bus, etc.) if you complete your transfer within two hours of paying your full fare with the same MetroCard. If you transfer from a local bus or subway to an express bus you must pay an additional \$3 from that same MetroCard. You may transfer free from an express bus, to a local bus, to the subway, or to another express bus if you use the same MetroCard. If you pay your local bus fare in coins, you can request a transfer good only on another local bus.

Senior and Disabled Fare - At certain times, **persons at least 65 years of age or who have a qualifying disability**, and who present valid identification, such as Reduced-Fare MetroCard, Medicare card, or MTA reduced fare card — are granted reduced fare benefits as follows:

- Local buses at all times.
- Express buses weekdays 10 AM to 3 PM, and, 7 PM to 6 AM, all weekend, and on holidays.
- Medicaid cards do not qualify.

Note: Until further notice, the student express bus fare remains \$2.50 in coin only with a valid Student Pass.

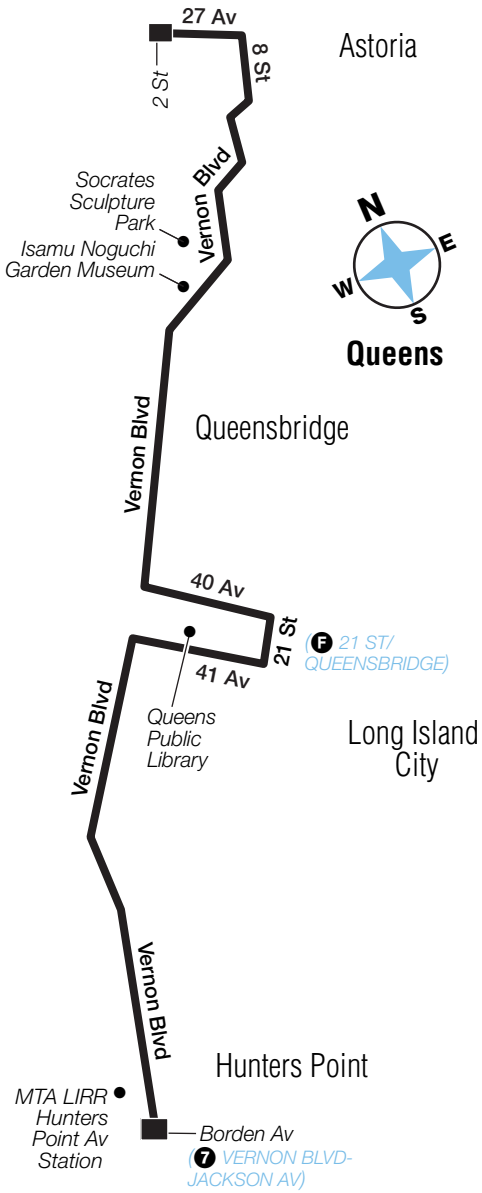
