STEP 1

- go to www.sfu.ca/prospectiveundergrads by February 28 and apply for early admission to SFU through myBCcampus (mandatory)
- you MUST also self-report your grades
- all applicants must pay the \$45 admission application fee in order to be considered.

STEP 2

Mail this application and supporting documents to SFU by July 15. Packages postmarked after July 15 will not be accepted.

STEP 3

Apply for an early bursary online at students.sfu.ca/financialaid before July 15.

SEND US THESE DOCUMENTS

- this paper application form, original or photocopied, completed and signed
- one reference letter from a supervisor of your volunteer work
- a one-page summary of your achievements and activities, demonstrating your involvement in volunteer activities
- one copy of your transcript that includes your grade 11 and 12 course marks to date.

All of the above documents must be fastened together and submitted in a single envelope. Documents must not arrive separately. Packages with extra materials will not be accepted.
