Dear madam/sir,

Regarding the information data about the digital terrestrial TV in Greece as well as the the switch off the analogue TV (according to the cocm05-44 document) we would like to inform you the following:

1. Greece is already separated in allotments relative to its geographical regions. For each of these allotments specific frequencies are assigned.
2. After that our Ministry had series of negotiations procedures with the most of the neighboring countries
3. After the negotiations and having done the appropriate changes, Greece submitted its digital plan to the ITU on 31.10.2005
4. The definite Digital Plan is expected after the end of Regional Meeting of ITU (RRC-06) in May of 2006
5. We estimate that the switchover can not be accomplished earlier that 2010. (2012 is a possible date). Nevertheless, the final decision also depends on the decisions of CEPT and ITU
6. Regarding the exact way that the switchover can be achieved, this is under consideration and not yet specified
