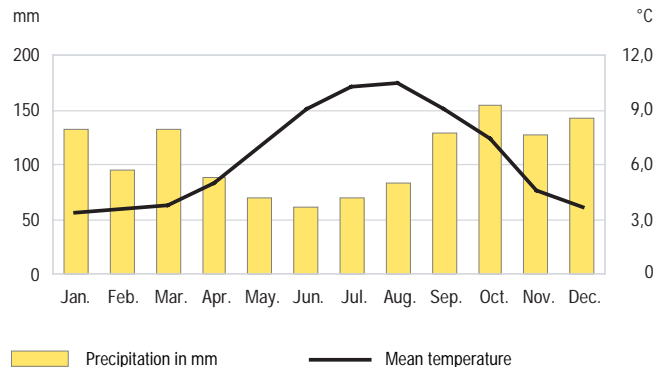

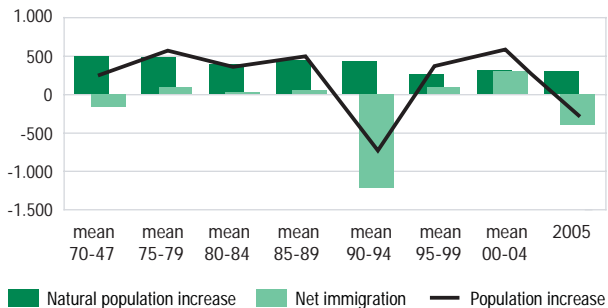

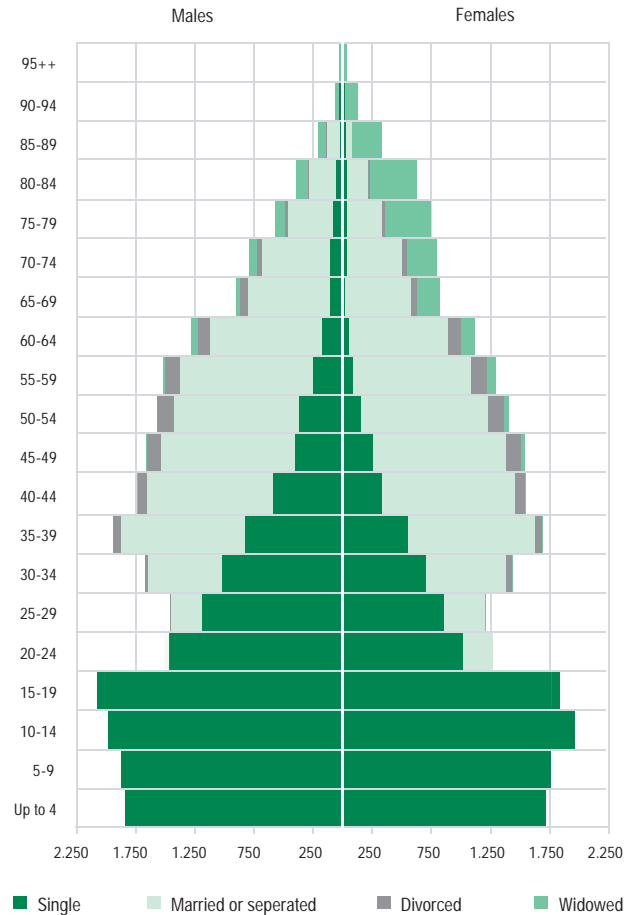

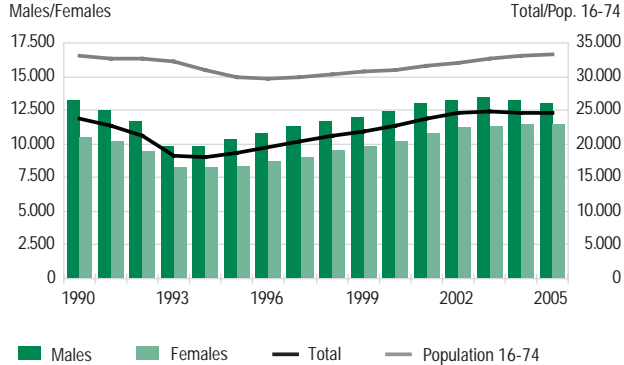

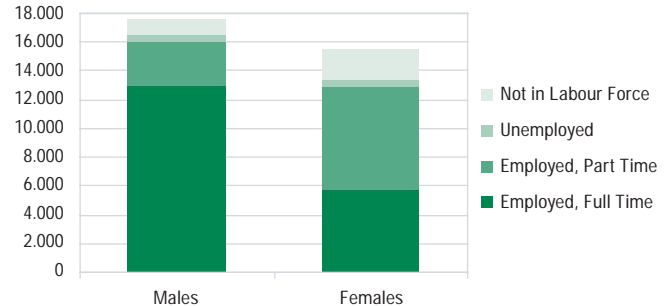

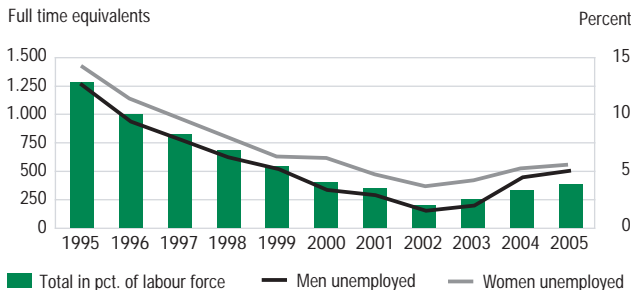

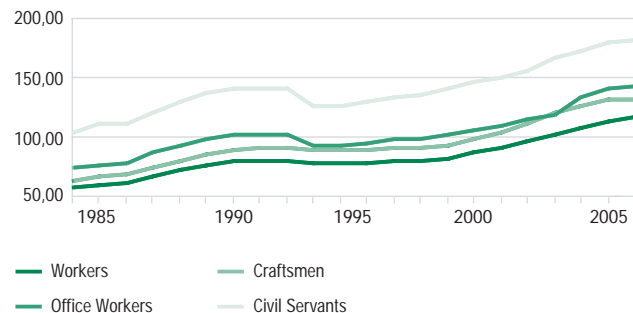

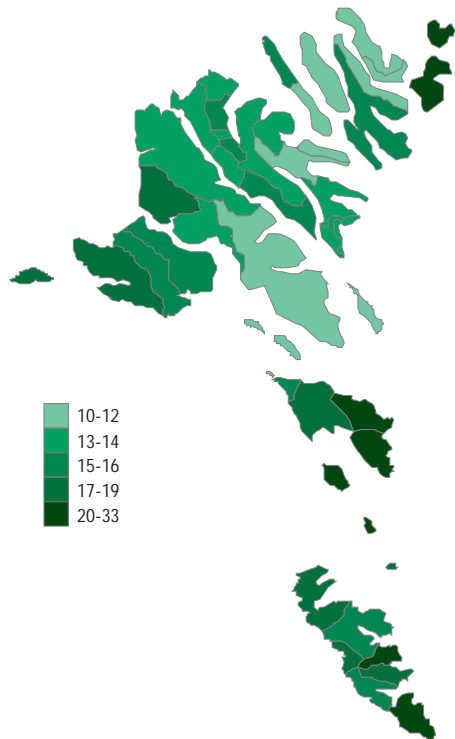
## Contractual hourly wages

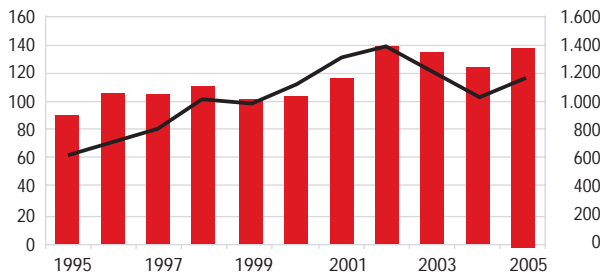

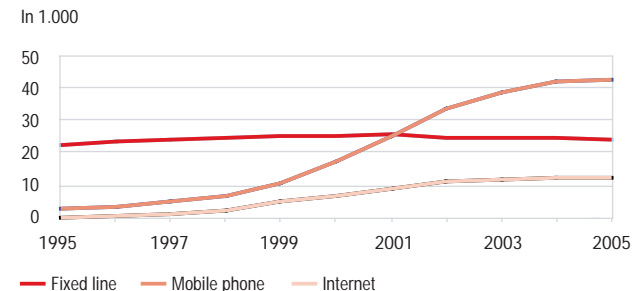

## Consumer price index, annual average rates

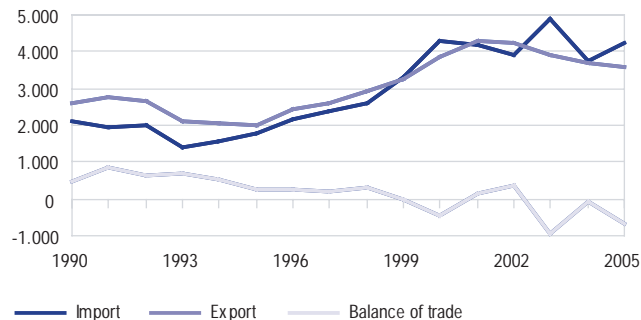

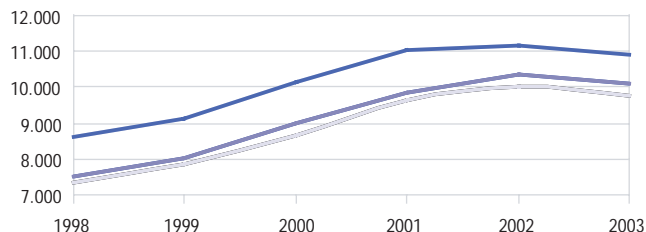
