

Snuggly Hood

Size: 28" around X 20 " long

Materials: chunky weight yarn. Sample was knit with Plymouth Baby Alpaca Brush yarn.

Keyplate 4 or bulky tension 6.

Gauge: 3.5 sts and 5 rows = 1"

Legend:

I - knit stitch


O - empty needle from transferred stitch

/ - transfer stitch to needle at right

\ - transfer stitch to needle at left

V - needle with 3 stitches





- 1. Ewrap cast on 97 sts with main yarn. Row counter at 0.
- 2. Knit 2 rows.
- 3. Starting at bottom and repeating across row, work graph to top.
- 4. Next row: Transfer the 5th and then every 8th stitch to adjacent needle.
- 5. Place empty needles in non working position.
- 6. Knit to row counter 94.
- 7. Work graph again this time starting at the top and working to the bottom of the graph.
- 8. Knit to row counter 102. Back stitch bind off.
- 9. Sew side seam. Block as necessary.

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
