Ottawa Senators Draft Notes

Draft Summary: The Senators have drafted a total of 152 players since their first NHL Entry Draft in 1992. Ottawa, with a first round pick at number '9', has only ever had this selection once. In 2005, the Senators picked defenceman Brian Lee.

The Senators today: Fifteen (15) players drafted by Ottawa have played at least one NHL game with the Senators and are currently in the organization.

Position Breakdown: Of Ottawa's 152 picks, 15 have been goaltenders, 58 have been defencemen, 26 centers, 27 left wingers and 26 right wingers. Seven (7) goaltenders have played in the NHL, 19 defencemen, 17 centers, eight left wingers and 12 right wingers.

Goaltenders: Ottawa has drafted 15 goaltenders in their history, including Mathieu Chouinard twice (1998 and 2000). Of those goaltenders chosen, Jani Hurme (1997), Simon Lajeunesse (1999), Martin Prusek (1999), Ray Emery (2001) and Brian Elliott (2003) have played at least one game for the Senators.

First Class: Ottawa has never been without a first-round choice at the NHL Entry Draft and had two selections in the first round during the 2001 Entry Draft. Twelve of Ottawa's 18 first-round selections have gone on to play for the Senators, including current Senators Chris Phillips (1996), Anton Volchenkov (2000), Jason Spezza (2001), Brian Lee (2005) and Nick Foligno (2006); four have gone on to play with other NHL teams. The Senators have had three first overall picks: Alexandre Daigle (1993), Bryan Berard (1995) and Chris Phillips (1996).

Senators and NHL Experience: A total 64 players selected by the Senators since 1992 have gone on to play at least one game in the NHL. Twenty-seven (27) of the Senators' picks have only played for Ottawa. Twenty-four (24) picks have played for both Ottawa and another NHL team(s). Thirteen (13) players selected have played in the NHL but not for Ottawa.

NHL Teams Where Ottawa's Picks Have Played: The Senators' picks have also played with: Anaheim, Atlanta, Boston, Carolina, Chicago, Colorado, Columbus, Dallas, Detroit, Florida, Los Angeles, Minnesota, Montreal, Nashville, New Jersey, N.Y. Islanders, N.Y. Rangers, Philadelphia, Phoenix, Pittsburgh, San Jose, St. Louis, Tampa Bay, Toronto, Vancouver and Washington.

NHL Experience per Round: Ottawa's first, second and third rounds picks have produced the most NHL players for the club: 1st round – 16 NHLers; 2nd – 10; 3rd – 8; 4th – 8; 5th – 3; 6th – 5; 7th – 3; 8th – 2; 9th – 7; 10th – 0; 11th – 2.

Picked to play in the NHL: Only 10 draft picks played in the NHL season immediately following their draft year. Tomas Jelinek (1992) was the first. Other players included: Alexandre Daigle (1993); Pavol Demitra (1993); Radek Bonk (1994); Stanislav Neckar (1994); Andreas Dackell (1996); Marian Hossa (1997); Magnus Arvedsson (1997); Toni Dahlman (2001) and Zack Smith (2008).

Time for development: While 88 draft picks have never played in the NHL, or have yet to suit up, one player took five seasons to reach the Senators and NHL, and another six took four years. Julien Vauclair (1998) took five years from his draft in 1998 to play his only NHL game during the 2003-04 season. The four-year players are: Josh Langfeld (1997); Chris Kelly (1999); Brandon Bochenski (2001); Alexei Kaigorodov (2002); Brian Elliott (2003) and Peter Regin (2004).

Diamonds In The Rough: In Ottawa's draft history, they have had seven players drafted in the ninth-round go on to play in the NHL. There were also two players selected in the eleventh round that went on to play for Ottawa (Thomas Jelinek and Antti Tormanen). Some notable late round picks by the Senators are: Daniel Alfredsson (1994, 6th round, 133rd overall), Andreas Dackell (1996, 6th round, 136th overall), Brian Elliott (2003, 9th round, 291st overall), Chris Neil (1998, 6th round, 161st overall), Martin Prusek (1999, 6th round, 164th overall), Sami Salo (1996, 9th, 239th overall) and Karel Rachunek (1997, 9th round, 229th overall). Brian Elliott's NHL debut during the 2007-08 season made him the highest drafted player ever to play for the Senators.

1995 Jinx: Other than the still developing 2007 draft class, 1995 is the only year in which no Senators draft picks have played for Ottawa, but four did play in the NHL. No players from the 1995 draft year remain in the organization.
