YARN QUALITY*	CROCHET HOOKS		GAUGE in sc rnds ON SMALLER HOOK
A 2 Fine 	3.25mm [US D-3] & 3.5mm [US E-4]		21 sts = 4"; 25 rnds = 4"
B 3 Light 	3.75mm [US F-5] & 4mm [US G-6]		18 sts = 4"; 21 rnds = 4"
C 4 Medium 	5.5mm [US I-9] & 6mm [US J-10]		13 sts = 4"; 14 rnds = 4"
D 5 Bulky 	6mm [US J-10] & 6.5mm [US K-10 1/2]		11 sts = 4"; 13 rnds = 4"
E 6 Super Bulky 	10mm [US N-15] & 11.5mm [US P-16]		5 sts = 3"; 8 rnds = 4 1/4"

Amount: One skein each of 2 colors of any yarn quality will make one or more hats.

NOTE: Circle the numbers appropriate to the hat size and yarn quality you are making to help keep track of the pattern.

HAT-Cuff: With **larger** hook and first color, chain

A	64	72	84	–	–	–
B	52	64	72	80	92	100
C	40	44	52	56	64	72
D	–	36	44	48	56	60
E	–	24	28	32	32	36

sts; join with a sl st to first ch, being sure ch is not twisted. **Rnd 1:** Ch 1, sc in same ch as joining and in each ch around; join in the back lp of first sc – the number of sc should be the same as the number of ch. **Rnd 2:** Ch 1, sc in back lp of each sc around; join in back lp of first sc. Rep Rnd 2 for

A-E	2 1/2	3	4	5	6	6
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inches. **Crown:** Change to **smaller** hook and second color. **Next Rnd (Right Side):** Ch 1, sc in both lps of each sc around; join; do **not** turn. Rep last rnd with one color or 2 colors for stripes until

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inches from beg. **Shape Top:** Ch 1; [*draw up a lp in next 2 sc, yo and draw through all 3 lps on hook – dec* made; sc in next

B	8	11	13	15	18	20
C	5	6	8	9	11	13
D	–	4	6	7	9	10
E	–	1	2	3	3	4

sts, dec, sc in next sc, place marker in last st] 4 times; join to first sc – 8 sts dec. **Next Rnd:** Ch 1, [dec, sc in each sc to 2 sts before marked st, dec, sc in next sc] 4 times; join. Rep the last rnd until the rnd "Ch 1, [dec, sc in next 0 **OR** 1 sc, dec, sc in next sc] 4 times" has been worked and 12 **OR** 16 sts rem. Work 1 rnd even. Cut yarn, leaving a long end; weave through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten securely. Fold cuff in half to the right side. **Optional:** Make a pom pom and fasten to top of hat.

C 4 Medium 	5.5mm [US I-9] & 6mm [US J-10]		13 sts = 4"; 14 rnds = 4"

Amount: One skein each of 2 colors will make one or more pairs of mittens.

SIZE	1	2	3	4	5	6
TO FIT	Preemie	Baby	Toddler	Child	Women	Men
CIRCUMFERENCE	4"	4 1/2"	5 1/2"	6 1/2"	8"	9 1/2"

NOTE: Circle the numbers appropriate to the mitten size you are making to help keep track of the pattern.

MITTEN-Cuff: With **larger** hook and first color, chain

	13	15	18	21	26	31
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sts; join with a sl st to first ch, being sure ch is not twisted. **Rnd 1:** Ch 1, sc in same ch as joining and in each ch around; join in the back lp of first sc – the number of sc should be the same as the number of ch. **Rnd 2:** Ch 1, sc in back lp of each sc around; join in back lp of first sc. Rep Rnd 2 for

	3	4	4	5	6	7
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inches.

Hand: Change to **smaller** hook and second color. Working in **both** lps, work 1 (2, 3, 4, 4, 5) rnds even.

NOTE: Directions for Preemie and Baby omit Thumb instructions; continue from ** to **.

Shape Thumb Gusset: Ch 1, sc in first

	–	–	8	10	12	15
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sts, [make (2, 3, 2, 3) sc in next sc] (2, 1, 2, 1) times, place a marker in the first and last sts made, sc across rem

	–	–	8	10	12	15
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sts; join – 2 sts increased.

Next Rnd: Ch 1, sc to marker, 2 sc in marked st, place marker on first of increased sts, sc to next marker, 2 sc in marked st, place marker on 2nd st of increased sts, sc to end of rnd; join. Rep last rnd until there are

	–	–	22	27	32	39
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sts.

Hand: Ch 1, sc over first

	–	–	8	10	12	15
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sts, ch (2, 1, 2, 1), skip next

	–	–	6	7	8	9
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sc; sc in last

	–	–	8	10	12	15
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sts; join.

Next Rnd: Ch 1, sc in each sc to sp, work (2, 1, 2, 1) sc in sp, sc in each sc to end; join.

****All Sizes:** Work even in rnds over 13 (15, 18, 21, 26, 31) sc until hand measures

	2	2 1/2	3 1/2	5 3/4	7	8
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inches from end of Cuff OR 3/4" less than desired hand length, decreasing

	1	0	0	0	2	1
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sts over last rnd – 12 (15, 18, 21, 24, 30) sc.

Decrease Rnd 1: Ch 1, * sc in sc; draw up a lp in next 2 sc, yo and draw through all 3 lps on hook – **dec** made; rep from * around; join – 8 (10, 12, 14, 16, 20) sc.

Work 1 rnd even.

Decrease Rnd 2: Ch 1, * dec; rep from * around; join – 4 (5, 6, 7, 8, 10) sc.

Cut yarn, leaving a long end; weave through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten securely. **

Thumb: Join yarn at thumb, sc across

	–	–	6	7	8	9
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sts at thumb, work 2 sc along hand side of thumb; join – (8, 9, 10, 11) sc. Work even until

	–	–	1	1 1/2	2	2 1/2
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inches from beg of Thumb.

Thumb Dec Rnd: Ch 1, * dec; rep from * to last (0, 1, 0, 1) sc; sc in last (0, 1, 0, 1) sc.

Cut yarn, leaving a long end; weave through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten securely. Sew any remaining holes at thumb.

Fold cuff in half to the right side; if desired sew end of cuff to beg of hand sts.
