#### 3. GENERAL INFORMATION :-

- A. The Rule of reservation of appointments is applicable to this post and the distribution of the vacancies will be as per the rule in force
- B. The number of vacancies advertised is only approximate and is liable to modification with reference to vacancy position at any time before finalisation of selection for Oral Test.
- C. If no qualified and suitable woman candidates are available for selection against the vacancies reserved for them, those vacancies will be filled by male candidates belonging to the respective communal categories.
- D. Certificate Of Physical Fitness: Candidates selected for appointment to the post will be required to produce a certificate of physical fitness in the form prescribed for "Other than Executive and Ministerial". The Standard of vision prescribed for the post is 'Standard-III.
- E. 3% reservation for Physically Handicapped persons, "Destitute Widows" and 'Ex-Servicemen' will not apply to this recruitment.
- F. Any claim relating to the selection (not related to candidature or/and claims made in the application) should be received within 90 days from the date of announcement of results. Claims received thereafter will receive no attention.
- G. Candidates belonging to Backward Class Muslims (i.e. BCMs) and Scheduled Castes (i.e. SCs) should fill-up Columns 6, 7 and 7(a) of the OMR application form and shade the boxes thereunder. <u>All the concessions / relaxations / benefits applicable to BC and SC candidates are also applicable to BCM and SC (Arunthathiar on preferential basis) candidates respectively.</u>
- H. "Arunthathiyars" means the castes, Arunthathiyar, Chakkiliyan, Madari, Madiga, Pagadai, Thoti and Adi Andhra within the list of 76 Scheduled Castes notified by the president of India under Article 341 of the Constitution of India by the Constitution (Scheduled Castes) order, 1950 as amended from time to time.
- I. The expressions "BC" (i.e. Backward Class) and "SC" (i.e. Scheduled Caste) wherever they occur in the Commission's 'Instructions, etc. to candidates', 'Information Brochure', OMR application form and Notification should be read as "BC (Other than BCM) and BCM" and "SC and SC (Arunthathiyar on preferential basis)" respectively.

#### 4. QUALIFICATIONS: -

# (A) AGE (as on 01.07.2009):

Minimum Age Limit : Should have completed 18 years (for all candidates).

**Maximum Age Limit** : Should not have completed 35 years.

(i) No age limit for SCs, SC (Arunthathiyar on preferential basis), STs, MBCs/DCs, BCs (other than BCMs), BCMs and DWs of all castes.

- (ii) Age relaxation of 5 years in the maximum age limit will be applicable to persons affected by the ban order, as per the orders of the Government.
- (iii) Candidates not belonging to SCs. SC (Arunthathiyar on preferential basis), STs., MBCs/DCs, BCs (Other than BCMs) and BCMs (i.e. 'others') who have put in five years of service in the State/Central Government are not eligible to apply even though they are within the age limit.
- (B) **EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION**:-Candidates should possess the following or its equivalent qualification on the date of this Notification viz. 29-07-2009:
  - Master's Degree in Physical Education (two years course) or Master's degree in sports or an equivalent degree with at least 55 percent of the marks or its equivalent grade of B in the University Grants commission 7 (Seven) points scale plus a consistently good academic records;
  - (ii) Record of having represented the University / College at the inter University inter Collegiate competitions or the State in National championships;
  - (iii) Passed the Physical fitness test;
  - (iv) NET or SLET or an accredited Test shall remain the compulsory requirement for appointment as Director of Physical Education for those with Post Graduate Degree. However, the candidates having Ph.D Degree in the concerned subject are exempted from NET, SLET, or an accredited Test for PG level and UG level teaching. The candidates having M.Phil degree in the concerned subject are exempted from NET or SLET or an accredited Test for UG level teaching only.

Persons claiming equivalence of qualification should enclose evidences for such claims.

- (i) The question papers for the above said subjects will be set in English only.
- (ii) The syllabi for Physical Education subject (2 papers) clubbed together so as to constitute a Single syllabus.

- 6. **EXAMINATIONCENTRE**: Examination will be held in Chennai centre only (Centre code-001).

Note:- Candidates should appear for the examination on their own expenses.

- 7. PROCEDURE OF SELECTION:- Selection will be made in two successive stages i.e., (i) Written Examination and (ii) Oral Test in the shape of an interview. The final selection will be made on the basis of the total marks obtained by the candidates at the Written Examination and Oral Test taken together subject to the rule of reservation of appointments. Candidate's appearance both in the Written Examination and Oral Test is compulsory. A candidate who has not appeared for the Oral Test will not be considered for selection, even if he/she secures qualifying marks in the Written Examination. (For further details please refer paragraph 22(b) of the 'Instructions, etc. to candidates').
- 8. **EXAMINATION FEE:** Rs.125/- . (Rupees One Hundred and twenty five only)

(For further details refer para 2 under part –III of Information Brochure and for Examination fee concessions, refer para 12 of the 'Instructions etc. to candidates'). Candidates (other than those who apply Online) should inform the Counter Clerk of the Post Office their OMR application Number for obtaining the Postal Receipt.

<u>Physically Handicapped Persons irrespective of their family income and Destitute</u> Widows are exempted from payment of Examination fee.

9. ENCLOSURES TO BE SENT ALONG WITH APPLICATION:- Copies of all certificates (including evidence for educational qualification possessed by them) as mentioned in para 15 of the 'Instructions, etc. to candidates' and item 25 under part—II of Information Brochure along with a Postal Receipt to the value of Rs.125/- pasted in the column provided in the application, unless exemption of fee is claimed. Information relating to debarment by any recruiting agency, criminal or any disciplinary proceeding initiated or finalised should be furnished along with the application. Original Certificates should not be sent. Those applying Online please refer sub para D of Para 12 of this Notification/Advertisement.

- (ii) Record of having represented the University / College at the inter University inter Collegiate competitions or the State in National championships;
- (iii) Passed the Physical fitness test;
- (iv) NET or SLET or an accredited Test shall remain the compulsory requirement for appointment as Director of Physical Education for those with Post Graduate Degree. However, the candidates having Ph.D Degree in the concerned subject are exempted from NET, SLET, or an accredited Test for PG level and UG level teaching. The candidates having M.Phil degree in the concerned subject are exempted from NET or SLET or an accredited Test for UG level teaching only.

Candidates should also furnish the particulars regarding arrest, convictions, debarment or disqualification by UPSC/State Public Service Commissions, participation in agitation or any political organization, candidature in election for Parliament/State Legislature/Local Bodies etc., if any, in a separate statement along with the application.

#### 12. ISSUE OF APPLICATION FORMS: -

OMR application forms can also be obtained in person from the sales counter of the office of the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission, Omanthoorar Government Estate, Chennai-600 002, on all the working days till the closing date upto 5.00 p.m. (excluding lunch interval between 1.30 and 2.00 p.m.) only on cash payment of Rs.30/- **Application forms will not be supplied to the candidates by Post.**
- C. Candidates should use only the OMR application form (AD or subsequent series). No other typed or printed or Xeroxed / Photocopy of the application form will be accepted and such application, if any received, will be summarily rejected.
- D. Candidates can also avail of the facility of applying Online on the Commission's Website at www.tnpsc.gov.in. Candidates applying Online should possess and keep ready Postal Receipt for Rs.155/- (i.e. Application fee Rs.30/- and Examination fee Rs. 125/-) obtained from any one of the Post Offices listed in Annexure-III to the Information Brochure before registering Online. Candidates claiming exemption from payment of Examination fee should possess and keep ready Postal Receipt for Rs.30/- towards the application fee. The Postal Receipt obtained for the payment of Application Fee/ Examination Fee should be pasted in the space provided in the application. Candidates applying Online shall also abide by the Commission's instructions laid down in this Notification / Advertisement/Commission's 'Instructions, etc. to candidates' / Information Brochure. Candidates applying Online should send their applications (i.e. The printout generated from the web site and signed by the candidate) with the Postal Receipt along with attested copies of Certificates so as to reach the Commission's office on or before the last date for receipt of applications, failing which his/her application will be rejected. The facility of applying Online will be closed on 29-08- 2009 at 5.45.p.m.
