

I, Daniel L. Siefert, state that:

I reside at 73 Hamilton - Bensenville, Ill.

and that to the best of my knowledge I hereby state the following:

I was formerly president of International Fiberglass, Inc. (an Illinois Corp.); resigned effective December, 1972 (just before X-mas).

Within 30 days prior to 10/6/1971 Joe Lombardo approached me and told me that "we got a check coming in to International Fiberglass I let me know when it comes in." I had no knowledge of what reason we would receive a check unless it was for business purposes. The check came in from Gylbur Products, Inc. on 10/6/71, (# 10013) issued to International Fiberglass, drawn on the Michigan Branch National Bank of Chicago. I deposited the \$5,500.00 check into the International Fiberglass checking account at the Bensenville State Bank.

Joe Lombardo came to me and directed me to issue checks for the same amount of money we received from Gylbur Products, Inc. I issued two checks, # 740 dated 10/9/71 for \$1,000.00 and # 754 dated 10/16/71 for \$4,550.00 to Joe Lombardo, allegedly for back wages.

I had no knowledge as to the reason Gylbur Products, Inc. issued the check to International Fiberglass. There was no purchase

of material or the sale of material' (or merchandise) <sup>NY</sup>  
by International Fibreglass from Gypsum Products Inc.  
Joe Lombardo directed me to issue an  
invoice in October 1972, to Gypsum Products Inc  
for 50 (?) ~~VACUUM~~ <sup>VACUUM</sup> forming dies to cover the  
check for \$5,250.00 we received on or about  
10/6/71, (and subsequently paid out to Joe  
Lombardo).


Joe Lombardo was in charge of operations

he represents us stockholders.


If Joe Lombardo directed me to do
