BT Wholesale is delighted to announce prices for the trial of its new Wholesale Broadband Managed Connect product (WBMC). This briefing supersedes the WBMC Indicative Trial pricing that was issued on 20 July 2007.

Launching in April 2008, WBMC will be trialled in January and February 2008 and will be available in two variants; Shared (aggregated) and Dedicated (point to point).

Shared Service

Although it will be available to all CPs, the WBMC Shared service is ideal for small /medium sized CPs. We collect traffic from all the WBC Aggregation Points and transport the traffic over a shared MPLS network to CPs' premises.

Dedicated Service

The Dedicated WBMC service is suitable for medium to large CPs, typically CPs with over 300k end users. However, individual CP strategies will determine their final solutions, which could be based on a mix and match approach (eg Shared and at certain nodes Dedicated). We will provide point to point dedicated links to transport the CP's traffic between WBC Aggregation Points, bringing the traffic together to be picked up by the CP where they have a network presence.

WBMC Trial Prices

The first 10 CPs who join the WBMC Trial will receive 90% reduction in their link charges (connection and rental) for their first two links. This will be for both the Shared and Dedicated services for the duration of the Trial. Remaining CPs who want to

What is WBMC?

WBMC will complement Wholesale Broadband Connect (WBC) providing an end-to-end Broadband service for BT Wholesale's CP customers. WBC delivers connectivity solution that will 21CN terminate at twenty aggregation nodes (subject consultation closure) in the network. WBMC will offer a value added service to aggregate the traffic from these twenty aggregation nodes and deliver to the CP's site. WBMC is a simple solution for CPs who want to offer end user broadband services, and provides a platform to support Broadband applications and add-ons that the CP seeks to introduce as part of its offering.
