Ongoing Incidents: Oden Road Fire (WA-NES-001262) is located 2 miles N of malott, WA. Primary fuels are timber, grass, and sage. The fire has burned 10,258 acres (+1,811) and is 70% contained. SR 20 has been reopened. Successful burnout operations on 8/24 have secured the NW portion of the fire. A Type 2 Incident Management Team (IC Johnson) is committed.

<u>Dry Creek Complex</u> (WA-MCR-000048) is contained at 48,902 acres. The fire has transitioned to a Type 3 incident at 0600.

<u>WA-OWF-782 Sable Fire.</u> This resource benefit fire is located 35 miles NW of Chelan, WA. There have been some smoke impacts to the Stehekin area but the fire remains well within its management area.
