Other must-see attractions include the local history collection at the Centenary Cottage Museum, with its memorial to Harry Chauvel who served with the Light Horse Regiment in the Boer War, and the Railway Museum.

In April every year, timed to coincide with the autumn backdrop, Tenterfield hosts 'Oracles of the Bush,' a four day celebration of Australian bush culture through verse, music and theatre. The Goanna Headland lookout is a great place to watch the annual migration of humpback whales and is a mythical site of great importance to the Bundjalung people, who have occupied the area for thousands of years.




