The Marketing Graphic Designer is a student staff member in the Recreation and Wellness Center. This position is responsible for using graphic design experience and skills to assist in the development of publications and promotional materials for the department of Campus Recreation.

Responsibilities

- Provides creative design, typesetting and layout for brochures, newsletters, posters, flyers, banners and other forms of advertising.
- Meets with supervisor to provide project updates and determine needs and suggest print/web advertisement solutions.
- Develops multi-page design layouts for annual reports, newsletters, calendars, and catalogues.
- Works with other staff to provide feedback and suggestions.
- Effectively utilizes illustration, photography and clip art to create unique design .
- Prepares charts, posters, signage and maps.
- Processes work requests, accurately logging project progress.
- Performs other related duties as assigned.
