Responsibilities

- Serve as the assistant to the Facility Coordinator.
- Serve as the Building Coordinator on weekends.
- Supervise Campus Recreation student assistants working in the 1604 Rec Center and Intramural Field House.
- Enforce Campus Recreation policies and procedures in a fair, prudent and professional manner
- Assist in training student Operations staff members.
- Assist with event set-ups with tables, chairs, sports and audio/visual equipment.
- Responsible for point-of-sale operations.
- Responsible for the safety of participants, the facility and equipment.
- Assist participant with questions, concerns and/or disputes.
- Assist with the inventory of game and facility equipment.
- Responsible for performing day-to-day activity supervision, equipment maintenance and upkeep of the Recreation Center.
- Assist with emergency situations and evacuations as they arise.
- · Complete required forms completely and legibly.
- Perform other duties as assigned.
