

Position Description Operations Assistant

Responsibilities

- Responsible for performing duties for day-to-day activity supervision, equipment maintenance and upkeep of the 1604 Recreation Center and Intramural Field House.
- Enforce Campus Recreation policies and procedures in a fair, prudent and professional manner.
- Provide customer service to participants by acting as a greeter at the Welcome Desk and answering questions.
- Ensure the security of participants, the facility and equipment.
- Assist with set-ups involving audio/visual equipment, event set-up with tables, chairs, stage and sound as requested.
- Operate point-of-sale terminal and perform membership and locker sales.
- Issue and inventory game and facility equipment.
- Wash, dry and fold laundry.
- Perform daily cleaning as assigned during the shift.
- Assist with emergency situations and evacuations as they arise.
- Assist disputes and minor problems.
- Complete forms completely and legibly.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications
