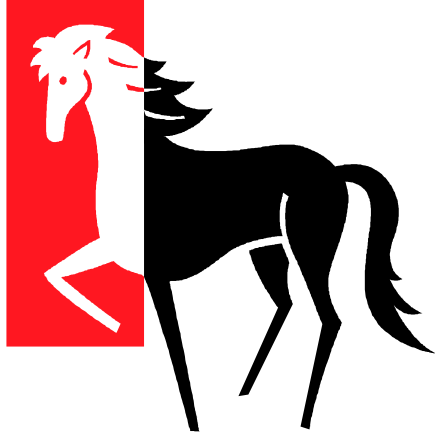

Please review your stall requirements as follows:

Only order the number of box stalls that are essential. Whenever possible use single stalls. This will help the CNE maintain costs by keeping more exhibitors downstairs. This will allow the CNE to meet more demands from exhibitors to be stabled downstairs. CNE will avoid complaints from exhibitors about those that are stabled downstairs and are using extra box stalls unnecessarily. Prior to move in if you realize that you do not need the number of stalls ordered it would be appreciated if you let the CNE know.

Hackney Horses & Ponies

All Animals must be registered with the CHS or AHHS.

The 2010 Equine Canada rule books include changes regarding pony measurement, specifically in section G111 which indicates that measurements of ponies are valid for three years, and requiring all ponies measured prior to 2010 to be re measured in 2010.

The CNE Light division (Hackney, Morgan, Saddlebred and Road Horse) is a primary show recognized by the Ontario Equestrian Federation and Equine Canada. All exhibitors are required to have a current valid membership in the Ontario Equestrian Federation.

Class 295 – Open Hackney /Shetland Team	Open Team Shetland/Hackney/Canadian Show Pony, Open to registered Hackney horses or ponies or Shetland Ponies, to be judged on quality, similarity, performance and manners.
Class 297 – Open Hackney / Shetland Tandem	Open Tandem Shetland/Hackney/Canadian Show Pony, Should be shown to a gig or suitable 2-wheeled vehicle. To be shown at a smart trot and to be judged on performance, quality, uniformity and manners. The wheeler should be of proper size for the shafts and possess substance and power for the work in hand, with some action. The leader to be slightly smaller than the wheeler notable for brilliance of action and beauty. A smart leader is essential for a good tandem. Variance of colour is acceptable but uniformity of colour is to be considered.

Morgan Horses

All entries owned by a Canadian resident must be registered with the Canadian Morgan Horse Association and entered under their full registered name and entered in the name of their registered owner. Foreign owned horses must be registered with the AMHA or the BMHS.

Class 305 – English Pleasure Stake	Horse must have been entered, shown and judged in class 300 or 345. Open to Stallions, Mares & Geldings. To be shown at a walk, pleasure trot, road trot and canter. To be judged on performance with the apparent ability to give a good pleasure ride, with emphasis on manners and gait 50%, type & conformation 50%. Horses not to be tested on obstacles. Horses may be stripped.
Class 310 – Open Hunter Pleasure	Open to Stallions, Mares & Geldings. To be shown at a walk, trot, extended trot canter and extended canter. To be judged on performance with emphasis on manners and gait 60%, type & conformation 40%. Horses not to be tested on obstacles.
Class 315 – Hunter Pleasure Stake	Horse must have been entered, shown and judged in class 310 Open to Stallions, Mares & Geldings. To be shown at a walk, trot, extended trot canter and extended canter. To be judged on performance with emphasis on manners and gait 50%, type & conformation 50%. Horses not to be tested on obstacles. Horses may be stripped
Class 320 – Open Western Pleasure	Open to Stallions, Mares & Geldings. To be shown at a walk, jog and lope with a light rein. Horses must back readily. To be judged on performance with the apparent ability to give a good pleasure ride, with emphasis on manners and gait 60%, type & conformation 40%. Horses not to be tested on obstacles.
Class 325 – Western Pleasure Stake	Horse must have been entered, shown and judged in class 320. Open to Stallions, Mares & Geldings. To be shown at a walk, jog and lope with a light rein. Horses must back readily. To be judged on performance with the apparent ability to give a good pleasure ride, with emphasis on manners and gait 50%, type & conformation 50%. Horses are not to be tested on obstacles. Horses may be stripped.
Class 330 – Open Pleasure Driving	Open to Stallions, Mares & Geldings. To be shown to an appropriate two wheeled vehicle at a walk, pleasure trot and road trot. One attendant without whip must head each horse. To be judged on performance with the apparent ability to give a good pleasure drive, with emphasis on manners and gait 60%, type & conformation 40%. Horses may be asked to back.
Class 335 – Pleasure Driving Stake	Horse must have been entered, shown and judged in class 330 or 350. Open to Stallions, Mares & Geldings. To be shown to an appropriate two wheeled vehicle at a walk, pleasure trot and road trot. One attendant without whip must head each horse. To be judged on performance with the apparent ability to give a good pleasure, with emphasis on manners and gait 50%, type & conformation 50%. Horses may be asked to back.
Class 340 – Road Hack	Open to Stallions, Mares & Geldings. To be shown at a walk, trot, road trot, canter and hand gallop. At any time during the class the judge may ask horses to halt and walk off on a loose rein. Class may be split for the hand gallop portion at the judges' discretion, for safety reasons. Excessive speed at the hand gallop will be penalized. To be judged on performance, manners and suitability for road hack 60%, type & conformation 40%. Rider's attire should be suitable for the saddle being ridden.
Class 345 – Classic English Pleasure	Open to Stallions, Mares & Geldings. To be shown at a walk, pleasure trot, road trot and canter. Horses must stand quietly and back readily. To be judged on performance with the apparent ability to give a good pleasure ride, with emphasis on manners and gait 60%, type & conformation 40%. Length of toe must not exceed 4-1/2", shoes not to exceed 16oz., no pads. Saddleseat attire only, Cross entering into the English Pleasure division is allowed.

Class 350 – Classic Pleasure Driving	Open to Stallions, Mares & Geldings. To be shown at a walk, pleasure trot and road trot. Horses must stand quietly and back readily. To be judged on performance with the apparent ability to give a good pleasure drive, with emphasis on manners and gait 60%, type & conformation 40%. Length of toe must not exceed 4-1/2", shoes not to exceed 16oz, no pads. Cross entering into the Pleasure driving division is allowed.

American Saddlebreds

All animals to be purebred American Saddlebreds registered with the Canadian or US Saddlebred Associations.

Note: Saddlebred Park Pleasure Horse

1. The Saddlebred Park Pleasure Horse should be stylish with finish and quality and well mannered. The performance should be animated and graceful as all gaits.
2. This section is open to professionals and amateurs.

SB173 Classes Offered and Specifications

1. In Park Pleasure classes entries must be shown with a full mane and tail. Horses showing in the Park Pleasure division may wear tailsets or bustles, but may not show with the tail gingered, tied or braced and unset tails will not be penalized. The use of artificial appliances or devices such as chains, shackles, rubber bands, blinkers (except when driving) or blindfolds are prohibited on the grounds before or during the show. Any animal with prohibited equipment must be disqualified from further competition at that show and forfeit all entry fees and winnings.

Class 400 – ASB English Country Pleasure	Country Pleasure horses must be plain shod suitable for trail riding without pads, bands, or any device between hoof and shoe. Entries must be shown with full mane and tail. Tails must not be gingered or put in any device (ie: tailset, bustle or brace). The fact that a horse's tail once has been set does not exclude participation. Braids, artificial manes and tail switches are prohibited. Shown at a flat walk, trot, extended trot and canter. Judged 75% on manners, performance, presence, and quality; 25% on total conformation.
Class 405 – ASB English Country Pleasure Stake	Must have been entered, shown and judged in class 400. Country Pleasure horses must be plain shod suitable for trail riding without pads, bands, or any device between hoof and shoe. Entries must be shown with full mane and tail. Tails must not be gingered or put in any device (ie: tailset, bustle or brace). The fact that a horse's tail once has been set does not exclude participation. Braids, artificial manes and tail switches are prohibited. Shown at a flat walk, trot,

	extended trot and canter. Judged 75% on manners, performance, presence, and quality; 25% on total conformation.
Class 410 – ASB 3-Gaited English Show Pleasure	Entries must be shown with full mane and tail. Horses showing in the Show Pleasure division may wear tailsets or bustles, but may not show with the tail tied or braced, and unset tails will not be penalized. Braids and inconspicuously applied hair in mane and tail are permitted. Shoe bands and pads are permitted. Shown at a flat walk, trot, and canter. Judged 75% on manners, performance, presence and quality; 25% on total conformation.
Class 415 – ASB 3-Gaited English Show Pleasure Stake	Must have been entered, shown and judged in class 410. Entries must be shown with full mane and tail. Horses showing in the Show Pleasure division may wear tailsets or bustles, but may not show with the tail tied or braced, and unset tails will not be penalized. Braids and inconspicuously applied hair in mane and tail are permitted. Shoe bands and pads are permitted. Shown at a flat walk, trot, and canter. Judged 75% on manners, performance, presence and quality; 25% on total conformation.
Class 420 – ASB Park Full M/T Open	This section is open to Equitation horses being considered for future transition to the Performance or Pleasure sections and prospects being schooled by professionals. Horses shown in any class in this division are ineligible to compete in the Saddlebred Performance Division (ie: Three-Gaited, Show Pleasure, Country Pleasure). To be judged on performance, manners, presence, quality, and conformation. To be shown at an animated walk (animated or flat), trot, and canter. Horses are to stand quietly.
Class 425 – ASB Park Full M/T Stake	Must have been entered, shown and judged in class 420. This section is open to Equitation horses being considered for future transition to the Performance or Pleasure sections and prospects being schooled by professionals. Horses shown in any class in this division are ineligible to compete in the Saddlebred Performance Division (ie: Three-Gaited, Show Pleasure, Country Pleasure). To be judged on performance, manners, presence, quality, and conformation. To be shown at an animated walk (animated or flat), trot, and canter. Horses are to stand quietly.
Class 430 – ASB 3-Gaited Open	Three-Gaited Saddlebreds should be the epitome of the beauty, brilliance, elegance, refinement and expression. Its gaits are collected and its energy directed toward animation and precision. It is shown with a roached mane with tail in set. Two year olds may be shown with a full mane and tail. To be shown at animated walk, part trot, and canter. Judged on performance, presence, quality, manners, and conformation.
Class 435 – ASB 3-Gaited Stake	Must have been entered, shown and judged in class 430 Three-Gaited Saddlebreds should be the epitome of the beauty, brilliance, elegance, refinement and expression. Its gaits are collected and its energy directed toward animation and precision. It is shown with a roached mane with tail in set. Two year olds may be shown with a full mane and tail. To be shown at animated walk, part trot, and canter. Judged on performance, presence, quality, manners, and conformation.
Class 440 – ASB Open Driving	(Country Pleasure, Driving Show Pleasure, Fine Harness) <u>Each horse will be judged on criteria for the division it represents.</u> (ie: Country, Show Pleasure or Fine Harness). Country Pleasure Horses and Show Pleasure Horses will flat walk, trot, extended trot. Judged 75% on manners, performance, presence and quality. 25% on total conformation. (2 wheeled cart) Fine Harness Horses will animate walk, park trot. (4 wire wheeled buggy with not top) Judged on performance, presence, quality, manners and conformation.

Class 1030 – Open Leadline Equitation	No entry fee, open to Children 10 and under, to be led by one capable handler. Performance of child and suitability of mount to be considered. Children entering this class may not enter any other saddle class at the show. This is not a costume class, rider's attire should be appropriate for any other equitation class, Saddleseat, Huntseat or Western. Stallions are prohibited. Ages of juniors are as of January 1 (calendar year).
Class 1035 – Open Walk Trot Equitation	Open to youth 12 and under, Saddleseat, Huntseat or Western. Rider may not enter any other saddle class at the show. Riders are to be judged on correctness of form and their ability to handle their animal. Stallions are prohibited. Ages of juniors are as of January 1 (calendar year).
Class 1040 – Open Saddle Seat Equitation under 18yrs.	(Open to all breeds, horses or ponies): In Saddle Seat Equitation, riders should convey the impression of effective and easy control. To show a horse well, the rider should show himself to the best advantage. Ring generalship must be taken into consideration by the judge. A complete picture of the whole is of major importance. Stallions are prohibited. Ages of juniors are as of January 1 (calendar year) Non-formal riding attire to be worn. Conservative coloured 3 piece saddle-suits are required. (no day-coats) Judges must eliminate those contestants who do not conform. Spurs of the unrowelled type; whips or crops are optional. Bridles shall be shown in full bridles (curb and snaffle) Saddle: Flat English-type. Gaits: Walk, Trot, and Canter. Entries shall line up on command and any or all riders may be required to execute any appropriate tests.

Open Class

Class 500 – Open Parade	500 Parade (Open to all Breeds, Horses or Ponies): Horses are to be shown with western-type, decorative <u>silver</u> saddle and bridle. Breast plates, tapedaros and serapes may be used as additional appointments. 75% performance, manners, quality, and conformation; 25% appointments of horse and rider. Desired characteristics are action, collection and brilliance. Gaits: Animated walk, Parade Gait (5km/hr max speed).
