Contrast A 43205 Shamrock 1 (1-1-1) ball

Sizes 4 mm (U.S. 6) and 4.5 mm (U.S. 7) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.** 2 st holders. Small amount of black and red yarn for mouth embroidery.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

Note: When working with more than 1 color in a row, wind small balls of colors to be used. Wind colors around each other where they meet, on WS, to avoid a hole at color change.

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

# Stripe Pat A

With B, work 4 rows stocking st.

With A, work 2 rows stocking st.

With C, work 2 rows stocking st.

With A, work 2 rows stocking st.

These 10 rows form Stripe Pat A.

# Stripe Pat B

With B, work 4 rows stocking st.

With MC, work 2 rows stocking st.

With C, work 2 rows stocking st.

With MC, work 2 rows stocking st.

These 10 rows form Stripe Pat B.

## **FRONT**

\*\*With A and smaller needles, cast on 50 (54-58-62) sts. Break A. Join MC.

**1st row:** (RS). With MC, \*K2. P2. Rep from \* to last 2 sts. K2.

**2nd row:** \*P2. K2. Rep from \* to last 2 sts. P2. Rep last 2 rows for 1½ ins [4 cm], ending on a 2nd row and inc  ${f 1}$  (1-3-3) st(s) evenly across last row.

51 (55-61-65) sts. Break A.\*\*

Change to larger needles and proceed in stocking st as follows:

**1st row:** (RS). With MC, K**7** (**7-9-9**). Knit 1st row of Stripe Pat A across next **8** (**8-10-10**) sts. With MC, K**36** (**40-42-46**).

**2nd row:** With MC, P**36** (**40**-**42**-**46**). Purl 2nd row of Stripe Pat A across next **8** (**8**-**10-10**) sts. With MC, P**7** (**7**-**9**-**9**).

Stripe Pat A is now in position.

Rep last 2 rows, keeping cont of Stripe Pat A until work from beg measures approx 4½ (6-6-7½) ins [11.5 (15-15-19) cm], ending with 10th row of Stripe Pat A.

Next row: (RS). With A, K7 (7-9-9). Knit 1st row of

Stripe Pat B across next 8 (8-10-10) sts. With A,

K36 (40-42-46).

**2nd row:** With A, P36 (40-42-46). Purl 2nd row of Stripe Pat B across next 8 (8-10-10) sts. With A, P7 (7-9-9).

Stripe Pat B is now in position.

Rep last 2 rows, keeping cont of Stripe Pat B until work from beg measures approx 6½ (8-8-9½) ins [16.5 (20.5-20.5-24) cm], ending with 10th row of Stripe Pat B.

\*\*\*Shape armholes: Keeping cont of Stripe Pat
B, cast off 3 (3-5-5) sts beg next 2 rows. 45 (49-51-55) sts.

Dec 1 st each end of needle on next and every

following alt row 3 times more.

37 (41-43-47) sts.\*\*\*

Cont even in pat until two reps of Stripe Pat B have been completed, ending with a purl row.

Proceed as follows:

Next row: (RS). Knit 1st row of Stripe Pat A across next 8 (8-10-10) sts. With MC, K29 (33-33-37).

**Next row:** With MC, P29 (33-33-37). Purl 2nd row of Stripe Pat A across next 8 (8-10-10) sts. Stripe Pat A is now in position.

**Shape neck:** Keeping cont of Stripe Pat A, pat across **12** (**13-14-15**) sts. **Turn.** Leave rem sts on a spare needle.

Dec 1 st at neck edge on next 3 rows, then every following alt row twice more. **7** (8-9-10) sts rem. Cont even until armhole measures **5** (5½-6-6½) ins [12.5 (14-15-16.5) cm], ending with a purl row. Cast off.

With RS of work facing, slip next 13 (15-15-17) sts on a st holder. Join MC to rem sts and knit to end of row.

With MC only, cont in stocking st, dec

1 st at neck edge on next 3 rows, then
every following alt row twice more. **7** (8-9-10) sts
rem.

Cont even in pat until armhole measures 5 (5½-6-6½) ins [12.5 (14-15-16.5) cm], ending with a knit row. Cast off.

**BACK** 

Work from \*\* to \*\* as given for Front.

Change to larger needles and proceed in stocking st as follows:

**1st row:** (RS). With MC, K**36** (**40-42-46**). Knit 1st row of Stripe Pat A across next **8** (**8-10-10**) sts. With MC, K**7** (**7-9-9**).

**2nd row:** With MC, P**7** (**7**-9-**9**). Purl 2nd row of Stripe Pat A across next **8** (**8**-10-**10**) sts. With MC, P**36** (**40**-**42**-**46**).

Stripe Pat A is now in position.

Rep last 2 rows, keeping cont of Stripe Pat A until work from beg measures approx 4½ (6-6-7½) ins [11.5 (15-15-19) cm], ending with 10th row of Stripe Pat A.

Next row: (RS). With A, K36 (40-42-46). Knit 1st row of Stripe Pat B across next 8 (8-10-10) sts. With A, K7 (7-9-9).

**Next row:** With A, P**7** (**7**-**9**-**9**). Purl 2nd row of Stripe Pat B across next **8** (**8**-**10**-**10**) sts. With A, P**36** (**40**-**42**-**46**).

Stripe Pat B is now in position.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat B, rep last 2 rows, until work from beg measures approx 6½ (8-8-9½) ins [16.5 (20.5-20.5-24) cm], ending with 10th row of Stripe Pat B.

Work from \*\*\* to \*\*\* as given for Front.

Cont even in pat until armhole measures 5 (5½-6-6½) ins [12.5 (14-15-16.5) cm], ending with a purl row.

Shoulders: Cast off 7 (8-9-10) sts beg next 2 rows. Leave rem 23 (25-25-27) sts on a st holder.

## **FINISHING**

Neckband: Sew right shoulder seam. With RS of work facing, smaller needles and C, pick up and knit 12 (14-16-18) sts down left front neck edge. K13 (15-15-17) from front st holder. Pick up and knit 12 (14-16-18) sts up right front neck edge. K23 (25-25-27) from back neck st holder, dec 2 sts evenly across. 58 (66-70-78) sts.

Beg on a 2nd row, work 7 rows in (K2. P2) ribbing as given for Front. Cast off in rib.

**Armbands:** Sew left shoulder seam. With RS of work facing, smaller needles and B, pick up and knit **58** (**62**-**66**-**74**) sts evenly along armhole edge.

Beg on a 2nd row, work 7 rows in (K2. P2)

ribbing as given for Front. Cast off in rib.

With C, embroider eyes using satin st.

Embroider center of Eye with A as shown. With black yarn, work chain st mouth as shown.

With red yarn, work satin st tongue as shown.

Sew side and armband seams.
