



 Funding provided by \$30,000 bond issue


> 20 patients / 5 staff members



Patient Characteristics (cont)

Admit and treat individuals who are court–committed and considered:

- dangerous to self

- dangerous to others
- highly vulnerable

Typically exhibit

- significant thought disorder, or
- severe mood disorder, and
- Co-occurring substance use


