Fire Status

- 1.940 acres burned
- 210 residences destroyed, 130 City of Santa Barbara, 80 County of Santa Barbara
- Damage assessment is continuing
- 5,446 homes evacuated
- More than 2,200 firefighters
- 22 injuries from smoke inhalation
- 3 burn injuries

Evacuation Area

The following evacuation orders are currently in effect. Additional information will be released as soon as it is available.

Mandatory evacuation orders are in effect for:

Eastern Boundary

- Cold Springs Rd between Sycamore Canyon Rd and East Mountain Drive
- Sycamore Canyon at Chelham Way (Neighborhood of Chelham, Paso Robles Drive, Stoddard Lane and Dawlish Place are open)
- Canon View Rd at Sierra Vista Rd.

Southern Boundary

 Sycamore Canyon Rd at 5 Points Roundabout. (Open to residents northbound up to the slide area)

Western Boundaries:

- Las Alturas at APS
- Loma Media at Los Alturas
- Las Alturas Rd at Conejo Rd.
- Stanwood Dr at Mission Ridge Rd.

- Stanwood Dr at El Cielito Rd.
- Mountain Drive at El Cielito
- Gibralter Rd East at El Cielito Rd
- Mt. Calvary Rd at El Cielito Rd

Northern Boundary:

 East Camino Cielo remains closed from Painted Cave on West to Gibraltar Road on East
