

HOW TO USE PE1

<p>1. To read a pattern on design card. Ex. 50 rows/38 sts.</p> <p>2. To knit using PE1 or to confirm a pattern.</p> <p>Ex. 50 rows/38 sts.</p>	<p>3. To format a Memory Card or to erase all patterns.</p> <p>Ex. To recall 8th pattern.</p>	<p>4. To store a pattern into a Memory Card.</p> <p>Ex. To recall 8th pattern.</p>	<p>5. To recall a pattern from a Memory Card.</p> <p>Ex. To recall 8th pattern.</p>	<p>6. To see how many patterns are in Memory Card.</p>
<p>* You can change between the pattern and the row number by pressing = key.</p> <p>(Inspection Switch ON)</p> <p>(Set design card)</p>	<p>* Display shows the reference number of the stored pattern.</p> <p>(Inspection Switch OFF)</p>	<p>* Display shows the numbers of rows and stitches of the recalled pattern.</p> <p>* To abandon the erase, press C key here.</p>	<p>* Display shows the number of stored patterns.</p>	
<p>* Use C key if...</p> <p>1. You make a mistake. (You can delete the last entry, one character at a time.)</p> <p>2. You want to stop PE1 from reading a pattern.</p> <p>3. PE1 doesn't work whatever key you press.</p> <p>4. Display doesn't show OK sign when you want to READ, KNT, SAVE or LOAD.</p>				<p>* The pattern read into PE1 is not erased by pressing C key.</p>

<p>7. To erase the last pattern stored in Memory Card.</p> <p>8. To copy all patterns from Memory Card to another Memory Card. Card A → Card B</p>	<p>9. To copy one pattern from Memory Card to another Memory Card.</p> <p>Card A → Card B</p>	<p>10. To combine patterns from design card and Memory Card.</p>	<p>* Read the pattern on design card. (Refer to No.1)</p> <p>LOAD → 3 (Pattern No.) → = → Set Memory Card (Card A) → = → Display shows the numbers of rows and stitches of the recalled pattern.</p> <p>To abandon the erase, press C key here.</p>	<p>* Recall the pattern from Memory Card. (Refer to No.5)</p> <p>LOAD → * → F2 → = → Set Memory Card (Card A) → = → Display shows the numbers of rows and stitches of the recalled pattern.</p>	<p>11. To combine patterns from Memory Card.</p> <p>* When combining more than three patterns, repeat from *</p>	<p>12. To read for Multi-Colored Jacquard. Ex. 72 rows/60 sts. 3 colored Jacquard.</p> <p>READ → 2 → F4 → 0 → F3 → 3 (Pattern No.) → = → Set Memory Card (Card B) → = → Display shows the reference number of the stored pattern.</p> <p>* Make sure that the patterns to be combined always must be the same width.</p> <p>* When working Multi-Colored Jacquard, always set Cam Lever to Slip and put the left light ON of Pattern Switch No.1.</p>
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
