The Maternity Unit offers support, education, practical assistance and personalised care to breastfeeding mothers. Lactation Consultants provide consultations at any stages of pregnancy or up to six months post birth, including prenatal education and advice, postnatal education and advice and practical help when learning to breastfeed. Assistance is also provided for mothers who are breastfeeding premature or unwell babies and for breastfeeding mothers who are unwell/require hospitalisation. Advice regarding breastfeeding and working or studying can also be given. Telephone support is available and, if needed, mothers and babies up to six months of age can attend a day stay service by appointment There is no charge for this service and no referral is necessary. Mothers who have given birth elsewhere are welcome.

### **Child Care**

There are a variety of childcare options available in the Ballarat community to suit a range of needs whether you are returning to work, undertaking further education or just wanting some time out for appointments or outings.

Childcare is Commonwealth funded. It includes Family Day Care, Long Day Care and Occasional Care. Family Day Care and Long Day Care operators must be registered under the quality improvement system known as National Childcare Accreditation.

# **Family Day Care (FDC)**

The Family Day Care Scheme provides quality childcare for children between the ages of six weeks and 12 years in the home of registered care providers. Children are cared for in a family environment and take part in the everyday routine of the care provider's family. Full-time, part-time, before and after school, emergency, weekend and overnight care is available. Care providers are registered only after meeting the scheme's selection criteria. The scheme monitors and supports the care providers by regular telephone contact and drop-in visits. FDC staff facilitate weekly playgroups for carers and children and provide care providers with on-going training.

#### **In-Home Care**

In-Home Care is provided by registered care givers who care for children in the child's own home. In-Home Care is available through the City of Ballarat Family Day Care Scheme for families who do not have access to a standard child care service, or where the child's needs cannot be met by an existing service. There is limited availability for this service.

#### **Supported Respite Care**

The City of Ballarat Supported Respite Program provides short term child care to families who may be experiencing difficulties including stress or illness. A qualified Child Care Worker comes to the child's home for three hours per week for a period of six weeks. The primary focus is to attend to the children's needs and provide a range of activities and experiences. Many parents use this time to take a break and have some time out.

### **Long Day Care Centres**

Long Day Care primarily caters for children from birth to school age. They are open at least eight hours a day, five days a week and 48 weeks a year. The services are regulated by the state and undertake a formal quality assurance system implemented by the National Childcare Accreditation Council. Ballarat currently has 16 long day care services.

The QA systems are an initiative of the Australian Government and aim to ensure that children in care have stimulating, positive experiences and interactions that will foster all aspects of their development.

## Education

#### **KINDERGARTENS**

Kindergartens provide educational sessions for children during the year before they start school. Kindergarten provides children with a great start in life. Qualified kindergarten staff run programs which develop your child's social, emotional, intellectual and physical abilities. Ballarat has a variety of kindergarten programs. These operate from a range of settings, including purpose built kindergartens, child care centres, community facilities and schools.

Research shows that children who have been to kindergarten are generally better prepared to start school. Kindergarten helps all children, including those with additional needs, to:

- learn how to make friends
- become more independent and confident
- spend some time with adults other than family members
- prepare for reading, writing and numeracy

To enrol, a child must turn four years of age by 30 April of the year they will be attending kinder. You will need to complete an application form at the centre of your choice. Applications can usually be made any time after your child's second birthday and before 30 June in the year before your child is due to begin kindergarten. Although applications will be accepted after this date, priority will be given to enrolments received by 30 June. The State Government provides a \$730 fee subsidy to assist concession card holders with a child attending a funded four-year-old kindergarten. For more information telephone 1300 731 947.

• Visiting Teacher for students with a hearing impairment. A qualified teacher of the deaf assists the hearing impaired student in their local school with speech and language development, communication and listening skills. The Visiting Teacher advises the class teacher and parents on the implications of the student's hearing impairment on learning and assists with any modifications required to access the curriculum. Information is provided re. classroom acoustics and the use of hearing devices is monitored.

• Visiting Teacher for students with a visual impairment. A qualified teacher of vision impaired or blind students supports their unique educational needs by providing specialised teaching and learning support in their local school. The Visiting Teacher supports the class teacher by providing resources and equipment, explaining the educational implications of the visual condition and suggesting inclusive strategies. The Visiting Teacher liaises and consults with parents.

• Visiting Teacher for students with a physical disability or health impairment. Students are able to receive support from a qualified special education teacher if their disability or health impairment has a significant impact on their education. Support is coordinated through their school principal, and lessons can be provided at school, in hospital or at home.

• Visiting Teacher for Autism Spectrum. A qualified special education teacher provides teaching and learning support to staff with strategies, information, classroom management, positive behaviour support and resources to meet the individual educational needs of the student with an autism spectrum disorder. The Visiting Teacher can provide in-class support, explaining and demonstrating the use of particular classroom strategies. Liaison and consultation with the parents is included.
