

CARRY-IN POLICY

Items permitted: bags no larger than 8.5" x 11", binoculars, cameras, blankets, jackets, items related to a medical condition, chairbacks (not more than 16" wide), and diaper bags (with child).

Items prohibited (including, but not limited to): bags larger than 8.5" x 11", food, beverages, containers, strollers, laser pointers, umbrellas, banners, flags, signs, noisemakers, weapons, inflatables, or any items deemed dangerous or inappropriate.

All items and spectators are subject to search.

Storage facilities are not available for checking prohibited items. Items left at gates will be disposed of accordingly.

Express gates are available at Camp Randall Stadium for those who do not bring carry-in items.

Halloween costumes may be worn at Camp Randall Stadium and the Kohl Center, but the costumes must be able to fit into a normal seating space and must be of an appropriate nature. No additional carry-ins will be allowed as part of a Halloween costume.
