

ABOUT THIS STATEMENT OF VOTE

The Statement of Vote reports the county-by-county votes cast for each candidate and measure on the ballot. For example, in a statewide contest such as United States Senator, the vote is reported by all 58 counties and listed in alphabetical order with the statewide total at the bottom. Candidates are listed in alphabetical order by party, with major parties first (i.e., Democratic, Republican, American Independent, Green, Libertarian, and Peace and Freedom). Write-in candidates are listed last. For example:

INITIATIVE AND REFERENDUM QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR 2007, 2008, 2009, AND 2010

(Based on the number of votes cast for the office of Governor at the 2006 General Election)

Initiative

The initiative process is the power of the people to place statutes and constitutional amendments on the ballot. These measures can either create or change statutes (including general obligation bonds) or amend the California Constitution. If the initiative proposes to amend California statutes, the proponents must gather petition signatures of registered voters equal to 5% of the total votes cast for Governor in the last gubernatorial election. If the initiative proposes to amend the California Constitution, the signature requirement is 8% of the total votes cast for Governor at the last gubernatorial election. A qualified initiative is placed on the ballot at a regularly scheduled statewide election that occurs at least 131 days after the measure qualifies or at a special election called by the Governor.

An initiative requires a simple majority of the public's vote to be enacted. A "yes" vote approves and a "no" vote rejects a proposed statute or constitutional amendment placed on the ballot through the initiative process.

Number of Signatures Required for an Initiative Statutory Measure: 433,971 [5% of 8,679,416 per California Constitution, Article II, Section 8(b)]

Number of Signatures Required for an Initiative Constitutional Amendment: 694,354 [8% of 8,679,416 per California Constitution, Article II, Section 8(b)]

Referendum

Referendum is the power of the people to approve or reject statutes already adopted by the Legislature. However, this does not apply to statutes that have urgency clauses, call for elections, or provide for tax levies or appropriations for current expenses of the state. Voters wishing to prevent a legislatively adopted statute from taking effect must – within 90 days of enactment of the bill – gather signatures of registered voters equal to 5% of the total votes cast for Governor in the last gubernatorial election. A qualified referendum is placed on the ballot at a regularly scheduled statewide election that occurs at least 31 days after the measure qualifies or at a special election called by the Governor.

A "yes" vote approves a statute previously adopted by the Legislature and allows it to take effect. A "no" vote rejects the statute previously adopted by the Legislature and prevents it from taking effect.

Number of Signatures Required for a Referendum Measure: 433,971 [5% of 8,679,416 per California Constitution, Article II, Section 9(b)]

NEW POLITICAL PARTY QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR THE 2008 AND 2010 PRIMARY ELECTIONS

(Based on the number of persons who voted at the 2006 General Election)

There are two methods by which political parties can qualify for official status which enables them to place candidates on a primary election ballot. The qualification deadline for each method is 135 days before a statewide primary in an even-numbered year, based on the registration totals as of the 154th day before that election.

- 1. **Registration**. No later than 135 days before the primary election, a party must have obtained registrations equal in number to 1% of the total vote cast in the last gubernatorial election. The current registration requirement is 88,991 [1% of 8,899,059 (Elections Code section 5100(b))].
- 2. **Petition**. No later than 135 days before the primary election, a party must have collected petition signatures of registered voters of any party equal in number to 10% of the total votes cast in the last gubernatorial election. The current signature requirement is 889,906 [10% of 8,899,059 (Elections Code section 5100(c))].

To retain its official status, a political party must maintain a registration level equal to 1/15 of 1% (0.00067) of the total registration of the state at all times [Elections Code section 5101]. In addition, after each gubernatorial election, each party's qualifications are reviewed. To retain its official status after the election, each party must:

- 1. Maintain a registration level equal to at least 1% of the entire vote of the state at the last gubernatorial election [Elections Code section 5100(b)]; or
- 2. Have a candidate for statewide office (Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, Controller, Treasurer, Attorney General, Insurance Commissioner, or United States Senator) receive at least 2% of the vote for that office [Elections Code section 5100(a)].
