

# How to make

Lincraft

## picot edge baby jacket

You will need



**100g balls of Patons Big Baby 4 ply yarn**

**3.25mm (No 10) knitting needles  
or size needed to give correct tension**

**Stitch holder**

**Length of ribbon**

#### **MEASUREMENTS:**

<b>Months</b>	0-3	3-6
<b>Fits underarm (cm)</b>	35-40	40-45
<b>Garment measures (approx cm)</b>	42	47
<b>Length (approx cm)</b>	22	22
<b>Sleeve fits (cm)</b>	11	12
<b>Quantity (100g ball)</b>	1	2

#### **Tension:**

27 sts and 55 rows to 10 cm over garter st, using 3.25mm needles.

#### **Jacket (worked in one piece)**

##### **First Front**

Using 3.25mm needles, cast on 60 sts.

Note - When turning bring yarn to front of work, slip next st onto right-hand needle, ybk, slip st back onto left hand needle, then turn and proceed as instructed, this avoids holes in work.

**\*\* 1st row:** Knit. **2nd row:** As 1st row.

**3rd row:** K48, turn. **4th row:** K48. **\*\***

Rep from **\*\*** to **\*\*** 18 (21) times, then 1st row once.

### First sleeve

**Next row:** K22, slip rem 38 sts onto stitch-holder.

Cast on 30 (34) sts for Sleeve ... 52 (56) sts.

\*\*\* Proceed as folls - **1st row:** K40 (44), turn.

**2nd row:** K32 (36), Turn. **3rd row:** K44 (48).

**4th row:** Knit. \*\*\* Rep from \*\*\* to \*\*\* 18 (20) times.

### Back

**1st row:** Cast off 30 (34) sts, K10, turn.

**2nd row:** K10, knit 38 sts from stitch-holder ... 60 sts.

Work as for First Front from \*\* to \*\* 25 (31) times.

Proceed as folls - **1st row:** Knit. **2nd row:** K22, slip rem 38 sts on stitch-holder.

**Second sleeve:** Cast on 30 (34) sts ... 52 (56) sts.

Work as for First Sleeve from \*\*\* to \*\*\* 19 (21) times.

**Next row:** Cast off 30 (34) sts, K10, Turn.

Second front - **1st row:** K10, knit 38 sts from stitch-holder and work as for First Front from \*\* to \*\* 19 (22) times.  
Cast off.

### Neckband

With right side facing and using 3.25mm Needles, knit up one st from each ridge around yoke.

**1st row:** Knit. **2nd row:** Knit every 5th & 6th sts tog.

**3rd row:** Knit. 4th row (ribbonholes): \* K1, yfwd, K2tog, rep from \* to end. **5th row:** Knit.

**6th row:** Knit every 3rd & 4th sts tog.

**7th row:** Knit. Cast off loosely knitways.

### Neck edging

With right side facing and using 3.25mm needles, knit up 71 (77) sts evenly along neck edge. Work 3 rows stocking st, beg with a purl row. Picot row: K1, \* yfwd, K2tog, rep from \* to end. Work 3 rows stocking st, beg with a purl row. Cast off loosely.

### Lower edging

With right side facing and using 3.25mm needles, knit up 109 (123) sts evenly along lower edge of Back and Fronts.  
Complete as for Neck Edging.

### **Front edgings**

With right side facing and using 3.25mm needles, knit up 61 sts evenly along right front edge, beg and ending at picot edges of lower edge and neckband. Complete as for Neck Edging. Work Left Front Edging in same manner.

### **Sleeve edgings**

With right side facing and using 3.25mm needles, knit up 37 (41) sts evenly along lower sleeve edge.  
Complete as for Neck Edging.

### **Make up**

DO NOT PRESS. Using a flat seam, join sleeve seams.  
Fold all edgings onto wrong side at picot rows and slip-stitch loosely in position. Thread ribbon through holes at neck.
