Thanks to the diligence of the first knitters who have received the Yarn Book, we can now add some details or correct some printing errors

Model nr. 882

On the diagram: there is no neck edge on the back; all the sts are cast off at the end.

Model nr. 913

Sleeves: Cont straight until sleeve measures 17-1/4 in (44 cm) from cast-on edge [end of **Row** 114 not 104 Rows].

Model nr. 914

Sleeves (not Left Sleeve: both sleeves are the same)

Model nr. 915

The pattern is explained for sizes 0-1-2-3-4, on the grid : Size 1 is really Size 0, Size 2 is really Size 1, Size 3 is really Size 2, Size 4 is really Size 3, Size 5 is really Size 4.



Both sleeves are the same. End Part B as follows:

When stocking st measures 9 in (23 cm) (64 rows) cast off 3 sts at the beginning of next 2 rows then decrease 1 sts at each edge (2 sts from the edge) of every following rs row 3 times. Cast off the 56 (62-70-78) remaining sts.

You'll then be able to sew the sleeves to the fronts at armhole level.



Helmet :...work in garter st for 2 rows. On next row k2 (garter st)., work 15 (15-19-19) sts of Pattern Stitch, k2 (garter st).
