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# Obama again narrowly lags Huckabee in NC but leads others

**Raleigh, N.C.** – President Obama enjoyed a little surge in popularity last month around the country, regaining plurality approval in North Carolina and for the first time leading all four potential Republican opponents tested against him in the Tar Heel State. But in PPP's latest poll, he has regressed back to even on the approval front, and now posts a hair-thin deficit to Mike Huckabee while still leading Newt Gingrich, Mitt Romney, and Sarah Palin in a state he won for his party for the first time in a generation.

Huckabee barely prevails, 47-46, after the president led, 49-45, in January. He has also slipped a little to Gingrich, who is now down only 48-44 (versus 50-43 a month ago). But Obama has stayed steady with the other two, leading Romney 47-44, the same as last month, and topping Palin, 51-41 (again almost exactly like the 50-41 last month). As in most other states, these candidates, already very well-known to voters at this early stage of the cycle, are not even as strong as John McCain was in his blowout 2008 defeat. Only Huckabee bests McCain's less-than-one-point loss here.

The main shift has occurred with independents. All the Republicans, even Palin, still do a better job of cutting into Obama's Democratic base than he does theirs. But while Obama led all four with independents previously, he now lags Huckabee, 40-45 (51-40 in January), and Romney, 41-42 (44-39). He can take some solace that his lead with unaffiliated voters over Palin has grown from 48-32 to 54-33, and that he still leads Gingrich by seven with this group.

"North Carolina is going to be one of the key battlegrounds next year," said Dean Debnam, President of Public Policy Polling. "Barack Obama looks a little weaker here than a month ago, but still appears to have a very real chance of repeating his surprise victory in the state from 2008."

PPP will release new numbers looking at Bev Perdue's standing in the state tomorrow.

PPP surveyed 650 North Carolina voters from February 16<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup>. The survey's margin of error is +/-3.8%. Other factors, such as refusal to be interviewed and weighting, may introduce additional error that is more difficult to quantify.
