Rep the last 2 rows until the row "[K2tog, K1 **OR** K2, sl 1, K1, psso] 4 times, K1" has been worked and 13 **OR** 17 sts rem. Cut yarn, leaving a long end; weave through rem sts, draw up tightly and fasten securely. Sew seam, reversing for cuff turnback. Fold cuff in half to the right side. **Optional:** Make a pom pom and fasten to top of hat.
