Duke Mathematical Journal: Volumes 1–100 (DMJ 100) is a fully searchable electronic collection of the first 100 volumes of one of the world's leading mathematics journals. DMJ 100 is available online through Project Euclid at projecteuclid.org/dmj100 and offers electronic access to 4,830 articles published from 1935 to 1999.

Only 255 mathematics journals published worldwide reach the level of impact required to be included in the rankings of the Institute for Scientific Information. Among these, *DMJ* is ranked at 10, with an impact factor of 1.758.

PRICING MODELS

1. Subscription

The *DMJ 100* collection is available by subscription. The 2012 price is \$275 for one calendar year of access (January to December).

2. Outright Purchase with Maintenance

A customer may purchase *DMJ 100* outright for \$4,000 with an additional access/maintenance fee of \$1,000 for twenty years of service (this fee, equivalent to \$50 per year for twenty years, must be paid up front). Duke University Press will provide electronic access (currently via Project Euclid) for twenty years from the year of purchase. This ensures that libraries will have continuous access to the latest version of the back files, which will be upgraded over time.

- issue-level metadata, including links from each article to MathSciNet and Zentralblatt матн
- Mathematics Subject Classifications for each article back to 1940
- MathJax display engine for formulas and symbols
