

Crochet Flower Keyring

Difficulty Level



Materials

YARNS

ECO WOOL CHUNKY 50g balls

Flowers pictured are in colours #2 (cream), #81 (seagull), #1725 (green/grey/blue/cream), #1729 (lilac/orange/cream), #1731 (purple spray), #1732 (navy/denim/cream) and #1733 (ruby/rosewood/hollyhock).

A Small Quantity is required for each Flower.

Use only the yarn specified - other yarns may give different results. Quantities are approximate as they can vary between knitters. Be sure to check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

NEEDLES & EXTRAS

- A 6.50mm (UK 3) (US K10½) Crochet Hook.
- A Wool Needle for sewing ends.
- A purchased Key Ring.

Instructions

2B LARGE FLOWER

Note - The pattern is written using 3 Colours, however flowers can be worked using 1, 2 or 3 colours, as desired.

Leave a length of yarn approx 15 cm long at beg.

Using 6.50mm Hook and Colour A, make 10ch, join with a sl st to form a ring.

1st round - Using Colour A, 1ch, working over end of yarn, 15dc into ring, sl st into first dc ... 15 sts.

2nd round - Using Colour A, 1ch, beg into same st as 1ch, (1dc, 3ch, miss 2 dc) 5 times, sl st into first dc.

3rd round - Using Colour B, 1ch, work a petal of (1dc, 3ch, 5tr, 3ch, 1dc) into each of next 5 x 3ch arches, sl st into first dc.

4th round - Using Colour B, 1ch, (1dc between 2dc, 5ch behind petal of 3rd round) 5 times, sl st into first dc.

5th round - Using Colour C, 1ch, work a petal of (1dc, 3ch, 7tr, 3ch, 1dc) into each of next 5 x 5ch arches, sl st into first dc.

Fasten off.

MAKE UP

Draw up yarn from beg in centre ring to close circle. Sew in ends. Attach flower to key ring.
