Hello.

You are now a member of the University of Exeter Students' Guild. Welcome Week is your introduction to life here at Exeter. The aim is to have fun, get to know everyone and have a brief introduction to student life. You'll also have a chance to complete all those last-minute administrative tasks, such as Registration (which is compulsory).

If you are having any problems then the Welcome Team are here to help—identifiable by their green t-shirts and hoodies, they'll be on hand night and day to assist you.

How to use this guide.

This is your essential guide to the week – it has a full list of almost everything happening on and off-campus during your first week. There are more events than ever this year, so don't worry if you can't do it all. Just make sure that you go to the compulsory events and try to fit in as much as you want around those. There's a blank timetable on page 47 so you can plan where you want to be.

Things you must do.

Register with the University Health Centre.

It's essential that you register with a Doctor as soon as possible for NHS treatment should you need it. Streatham Campus based students can register at the Student Health Centre at Reed Mews between 9 am—5 pm, Monday to Friday. Students on St. Luke's should get information from their academic schools on medical registration.

Visit the Library.

You can get into the Libraries and borrow books using your UniCard. Welcome Week is a good time to learn where books and journals for your subject are stored, before the rush.

Activate your IT Account and Register online with the University.

Please visit https://as.exeter.ac.uk/itreg/index.php to collect your user name and password, then follow the link to MyExeter, the student portal, where you will be able to formally register with the University.

Checklist.

There are a number of events which are marked as compulsory, some of these are specific to certain groups of students; specific subject disciplines, postgraduate students, international students or students in specific residences. The squares next to an event tell you whether it is compulsory – and they also inform you of the target audience, though most social events are open to everyone.

Some events have more than one session on different days and times, but you only need to go to each event once.


