

FAQ - iBrowse™ 2.0



Q: What is the Electronic Edition?

A: It is an exact digital replica of the printed paper.

Q: Can I search and zoom in the eEdition?

A: Yes. Unlike printed publications, you can quickly search the publication you are currently reading and zoom in on articles and photos using the zoom icon on the toolbar.

Q: Can I print the eEdition?

A: Some publishers allow subscribers to print their digital content. If so, simply click on the PDF icon in the toolbar. This allows you to save the current page as a PDF file. Once the file is saved, you may open it and use the native Adobe Reader printing options to print content.

Q: What is the Adobe Flash Plug-in and where do I get it?

A: The Adobe Flash Plug-in is a free web browser plugin from Adobe. It displays content created with Adobe Flash such as web application front-ends, high-impact website user interfaces, interactive online advertising, and short-form to long-form animation. This plug-in is widely used, and is installed automatically with all major browsers. If for some reason it is not installed, the application will automatically check for it and, if not found, will offer to install it for you.

Q: What are the system requirements needed to view the Electronic Edition?

A: The following shows the minimum requirements:

- 256 MB or more of RAM
- A High Speed Internet connection such as cable or DSL.
- Windows® XP with latest patches
- Windows® Vista with latest patches
- MAC OS X 10.4 or greater

A: One of the following Internet browsers running the latest version of the Adobe Flash plugin is required:

- Internet Explorer® version 7.0 or greater
- Firefox 2.0 or greater
- Safari 2.0 or greater
- Google Chrome
