

## Ladybug Dishcloth

■ ■ ■ ■ ■ EASY

### Finished Size:

9"w x 9<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>"h (23 cm x 23.5 cm)

### MATERIALS

100% Cotton Medium



Weight Yarn

[2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> ounces, 122 yards

(70 grams, 109 meters)

per ball]: One ball

Knook size G (4 mm)

**GAUGE:** In Stockinette Stitch (knit one row, purl one row), 15 sts = 4" (10 cm)



### DISHCLOTH

Ch 35.

Pick up 34 sts on foundation ch: 35 sts.

**Rows 1-7:** Knit across.

**Row 8 AND ALL WRONG SIDE ROWS THROUGH Row 50:** K4, P 27, K4.

**Row 9 (Right side):** Knit across.

**Row 11:** K9, P1, K 15, P1, K9.

**Row 13:** K9, P1, K4, P3, K1, P3, K4, P1, K9.

**Row 15:** K8, P1, K3, P5, K1, P5, K3, P1, K8.

**Row 17:** K8, P2, K1, (P6, K1) twice, P2, K8.

**Row 19:** K 10, P2, K3, P2, K1, P2, K3, P2, K 10.

**Row 21:** K6, P1, K3, P7, K1, P7, K3, P1, K6.

**Row 23:** K6, P2, K2, P7, K1, P7, K2, P2, K6.

**Row 25:** K7, P1, K2, P7, K1, P7, K2, P1, K7.

**Row 27:** K7, P2, K1, (P7, K1) twice, P2, K7.

**Row 29:** K 10, P2, K3, P2, K1, P2, K3, P2, K 10.

**Row 31:** K 11, P6, K1, P6, K 11.

**Row 33:** K 12, P5, K1, P5, K 12.

**Row 35:** K 13, P4, K1, P4, K 13.

**Row 37:** K 11, P3, K1, P5, K1, P3, K 11.

**Row 39:** K 10, P2, K4, P3, K4, P2, K 10.

**Row 41:** K 10, P1, K5, P1, K1, P1, K5, P1, K 10.

**Row 43:** K9, P1, K6, P1, K1, P1, K6, P1, K9.

**Row 45:** K 15, P2, K1, P2, K 15.

**Row 47:** Knit across.

**Row 49:** Knit across.

**Rows 51-56:** Knit across.

Bind off all sts in **knit**.



# General Instructions

## ABBREVIATIONS

ch(s)	chain(s)
cm	centimeters
K	knit
mm	millimeters
P	purl
st(s)	stitch(es)

( ) or [ ] — contains explanatory remarks.

colon (:) — the number(s) given after a colon at the end of a row denote(s) the number of stitches you should have on that row or round.

right vs. wrong side — On the finished piece, the right side of your work is the side that the public will see.

## GAUGE

Gauge is a measurement of the number of stitches and rows in a 4" (10 cm) square piece in the pattern you're working. Finding the exact gauge is not important for this pattern as the Dishcloth can be a little larger or smaller without changing the overall effect.
