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My work has continued to be informed by an understanding of and sensitivity to the history of ceramics medium through the exploration of the expressive potentialities of the vessel. I have also been a keen observer of the everyday objects of both a domestic and spiritual/religious nature that various cultures have made and used.

I have long used the vessel as a metaphor for the body, especially the zoomorphic. In particular, the jug as both container and pourer, signifying both abundance and generosity, has held my interest for over 20 years.

The characteristics of fauna and flora, vines, leaves, flowers, and birds inhabit the forms and are a reference to my personal experience and the environment in which I live.
