Time: 10:30 am - 12:00 pm

Location: Kids Camp, 139 Lincoln-Laurel Road, Frelinghuysen NJ

Directions: Take Route 80 West to Exit 12 for Hope/Blairstown. Stay to the right off the exit and merge onto Route 521 North. Follow Route 521 for half a mile and turn right onto Route 608 North (Silver Lake Road). Take Route 608 to its end and turn right onto Route 94 North at Marksboro (church and deli). Leaving Marksboro continue half a mile on Route 94 and take the road that forks to the left, Lincoln Laurel Road. Proceed 1.5 miles; Kids Camp is on the left. Look for the large wooden sign on the left.
