We present this report to provide you with a clear picture of what Freedom House has accomplished in 2007, much of which would not be possible without the help of supporters like you.

We would like to take this opportunity to recognize and express our appreciation for the kindness and generosity of the many individuals, foundations and corporations who have supported our work.

We have come a long way since our founding in 1941. When we first began publishing *Freedom in the World* in 1972, only 40 countries were classified as free. That number has more than doubled over the past 36 years, and today 90 countries, representing 46 percent of the global population, are classified as free. However, freedom is still under threat around the globe. The two billion people who are still denied fundamental freedoms need our help.

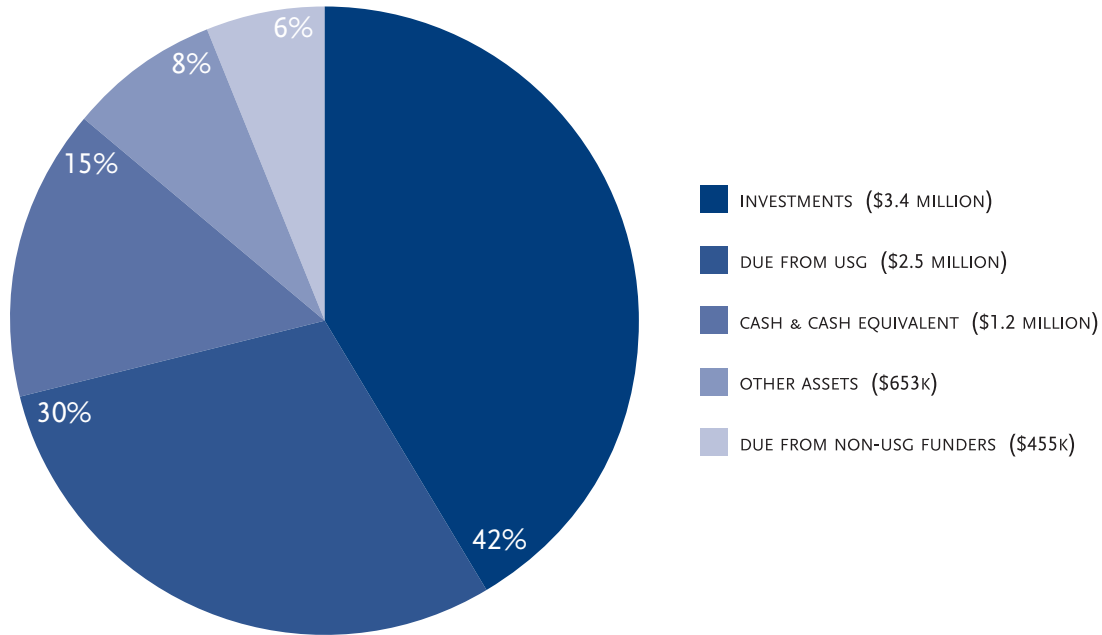

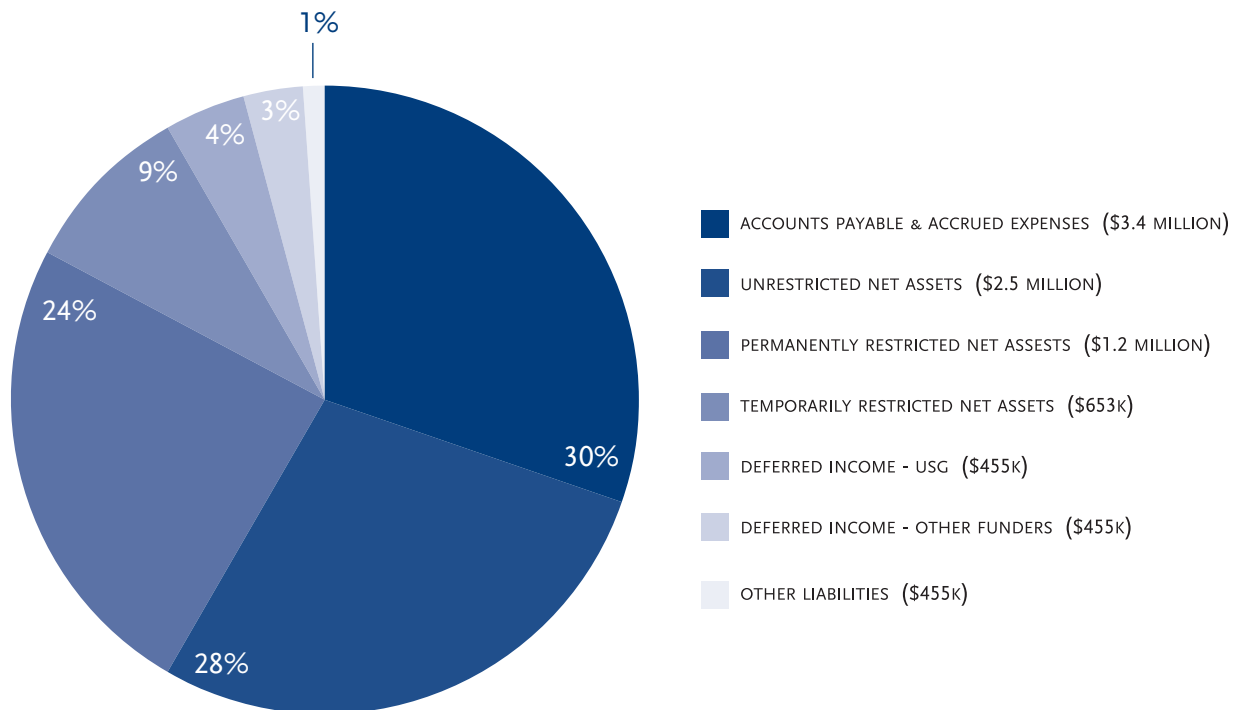

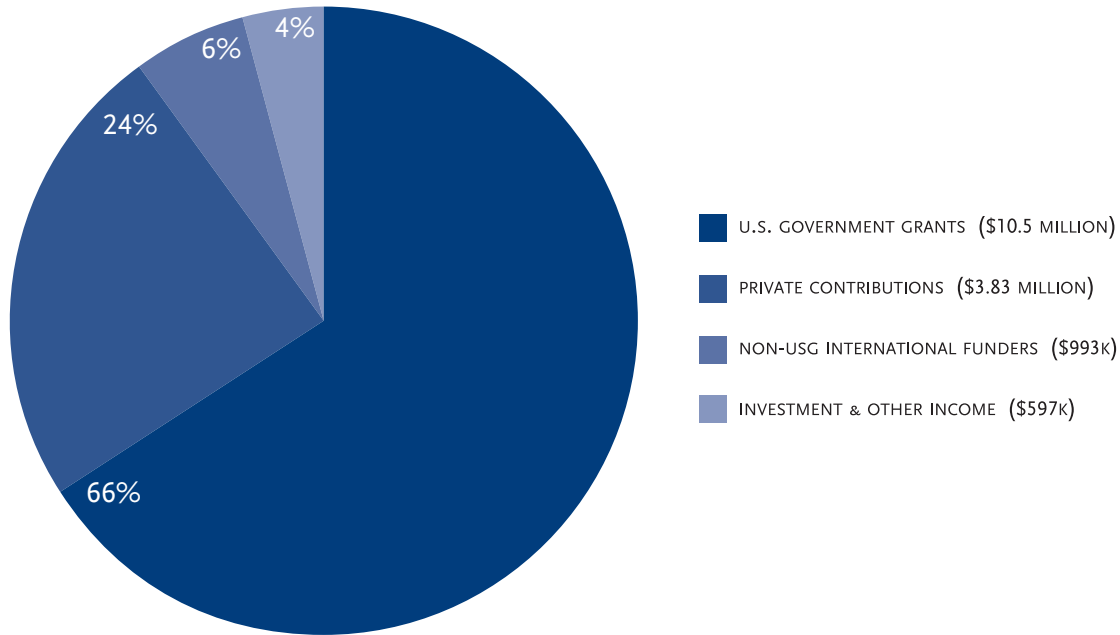
## 2007 Total Assets – \$8.21 million



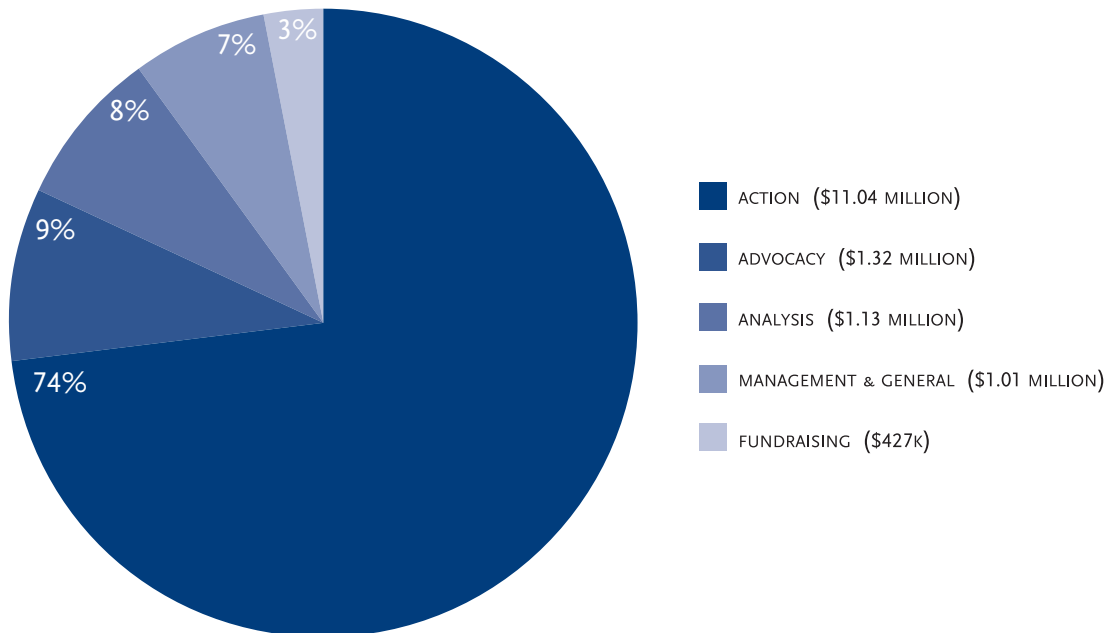
## 2007 Liabilities & Net Assets – \$8.21 million
