

Leopard Costume Accessories

Supplies:

1 yd. 2" Leopard fur Trimtex

1 Plastic headband

Ribbon (measure waist size plus 20" to form bow)

Directions for Tail:

1. Cut 2 lengths of leopard fur 24" long.
2. With right sides together stitch along both long edges and one short edge. Turn.
3. Sew the midpoint of ribbon piece to open end of the tail with slipstitch. Close opening, letting the ends of the ribbon hang free to tie around waist.

Directions for Ears Headband:

1. Cut 2 pieces of leopard fur trim 7" long.
2. With wrong side up fold corners of 1 short end in toward center until they meet, forming an "ear" at the top. Glue to hold folds in place.
3. Tuck raw edge of ear under headband, wrapping back up and slipping end into ear. Stitch in place.
4. Repeat for second ear.
