DECLARATION OF
NICK HANDY

I, Nick Handy, declare as follows:

1. I am over eighteen years of age and competent to testify. I serve as Director of Elections in the Office of the Secretary of State for the state of Washington. I was appointed to this position in May 2004 by Secretary of State Sam Reed, and have served in this position for over four years.

2. I supervise all of the operations of the Elections Division of the Secretary of State's Office, and oversee administration of state and federal elections, including the state primary and general elections. I am familiar with the following information in that capacity.

3. I am aware that Petitioners have asked this Court to authorize the issuance of a subpoena directing the Secretary of State to produce "the Declaration of Candidacy of Barack Obama as filed in the State of Washington," Mot. For Expedited Disc. And For Auth. To Issue Subpoenas (Mot. For Expedited Disc.) at 2. In Washington, candidates for President and Vice-President of the United States qualify to appear on the general election ballot when the national convention of a major political party certifies that they are nominees of that convention. RCW 29A.56.320, .360. Candidates for President and Vice-President do not file declarations of candidacy. RCW 29A.24.030. Attached as Exhibit A is a true and correct copy of the Official Certification of Nomination of Barack Obama and Joe Biden as the nominees of the National Convention of the Democratic Party, as filed with the Secretary of State. Attached as Exhibit B is a true and correct copy of certification of their slate of electors supporting their candidacy, as required by RCW 29A.56.320 and .360. Exhibits A and B are, accordingly, the nearest equivalent documents to a declaration of candidacy for a major party Presidential candidate.

4. I am also aware that the Petitioners have asked this Court to authorize the issuance of a subpoena directing the Secretary of State to produce “all records concerning the candidacy and disallowance of Socialist Worker’s Party candidate Frank Colero within the Secretary of State’s Office.” Mot. For Expedited Disc. at 2. At other points in their pleadings, Petitioners identify the candidate in question as “Roger Calero.” Decl. of Steven Pidgeon, ¶ 9. The Secretary of State’s Office has no records meeting this description, using either of those names. Attached as Exhibit C are true and correct copies of records concerning the nomination of candidates for President and Vice-President by the Socialist Workers Party.¹ The only individual identified as their nominee for President is James E. Harris, the name that in fact appeared on the general election ballot in Washington. The only document we have located containing the name of Roger Calero as a 2008 candidate for President of the Socialist Workers Party is an email thread, attached as Exhibit D. We received no documents seeking to qualify Mr. Calero, or Colero, as a candidate for President. Exhibits C and D are, accordingly, the closest documents we have to anything that would be responsive to the

Petitioners' request for documents concerning the candidacy of Mr. Calero or Colero.

5. On December 15, 2008, as required by federal and state statute, the presidential electors for the state of Washington met at the State Capitol in Olympia to cast their electoral votes for President and Vice-President. Attached as Exhibit E is a true and correct copy of the Certificate of the Electoral College of the state of Washington, signed by the electors and attested by Secretary of State Sam Reed. The transmittal of this certificate to federal officials is the last official act of any official of the state of Washington regarding the 2008 presidential election.

6. I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the state of Washington that the foregoing is true and correct and of my own knowledge, and that I executed this declaration at Olympia, Washington, in the County of Thurston, this 16th day of December, 2008.

We are currently being sued about the birthplace of Obama, whether he is native-born, and I presume my answer is also true for that situation, that we simply place the ticket on the ballot as submitted by the convention. I have copied in folks from the Elections Division to make sure I have stated this correctly.
