

## Pine Tree Doily

## WC1902



## Doily measures approx 13".

Aunt Lydia's® Classic Crochet Thread, size 10: 1 ball 622 Kerry Green.

Crochet Hook: 1.5 mm [US 7].

GAUGE: Rounds 1-3 = 2" between points. Finished motif measures approximately $31 / 4$ " in diameter. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the specified gauge.

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS:

Picot: Ch 3 , sl st in top of sc to close.
Tr-picot: Work 1 picot; *ch 3 , sl st in same closing st as first picot to close; repeat from * 1 more time.

## MOTIF

Ch 5; join with a slip st to make a ring.
Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in ring, [ch 5, sc in ring] 5 times; join with ch 2 , dc in first sc (counts as ch- 5 space) 6 ch- 5 spaces.

Rnd 2: Sc in first ch-5 space, [ch 7, sc in next ch-5 space] 5 times; join with ch 3 , tr in first sc (counts as ch-7 space).

Rnd 3: (SI st, ch 3 [counts as dc], 2 dc) in first ch-7 space, *(3 dc, ch 5, 3 dc) in next ch-7 space; repeat from * 4 more times, 3 dc in first ch-7 space, ch 5 ; join with a sl st in top of beginning ch-3. 36 dc and $6 \mathrm{ch}-5$ spaces.

Rnd 4: SI st in next 2 dc , sl st in space before next 3-dc group, ch 3 (counts as hdc, ch 1 ), ${ }^{*}(\mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2$, dc, ch 3 , tr, ch 3 , dc, ch 2 , dc) in next ch- 5 space, ch 1 , hdc in space between next two 3 -dc groups, ch 1; repeat from * 4 more times, (dc, ch 2, dc, ch 3, tr, ch 3, dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch-5 space, ch 1 ; join with sl st in $2 n d$ ch of beginning ch-3.

Round 5: Ch 1, sc in same ch as join, *picot, skip next ch-1 space, sc in next dc, 2 sc in next ch-2 space, sc in next dc, picot, 3 sc in next ch-3 space, sc in next tr, trpicot, 3 sc in next ch-3 space, sc in next dc, picot, 2 sc in next ch-2 space, sc in next dc, skip next ch- 1 space, sc in next hdc; repeat from * 4 more times, picot, skip next ch-1 space, sc in next dc, 2 sc in next ch-2 space, sc in next dc, picot, 3 sc in next ch-3 space, sc in next tr, tr-picot, 3 sc in next ch-3 space, sc in next dc, picot, 2 sc in next ch-2 space, sc in next dc, skip next ch-1 space; join with a sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

After the first motif, the remaining 9 motifs will be joined at the tr-picot points as you work. To join, work 1st picot, ch 2, drop loop off hook, insert hook through the picot loop at the tip of a point of the finished motif, pick up the loop, ch 1 and continue the tr-picot as directed.

The base row has 4 motifs, the next row has 3 , the next row has 2 and there is 1 motif at the top.

Weave in all ends. Block and lightly stiffen.

Art. 154 available in White and Ecru - 400 yd ( 368 m );
Solid - 350 yd ( 322 m ), and Shaded - 300 yd ( 276 m ) balls.

ABBREVIATIONS: ch(s) = chain(s); dc = double crochet; grp(s) = group(s); $\mathbf{m m}=$ millimeters; $\mathbf{s c}=$ single crochet; sl st = slip stitch; st(s) = stitch(es); tr = treble crochet; Yo = yarn over; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated; [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
