The Kansas contract was established through a partnership with Short's Sports and Event Logistics. The NCAA has designated Willow Run as the airport of choice for team and media travel. This air traffic represents another shot in the arm for USA Jet. Recently the firm launched a Fixed Base of Operations (FBO), where aircraft can park, refuel, and where pilots can develop their flight plans using the FBO's systems. USA Jet's FBO will host all three teams, as the firm's technical crews will provide ground handling services for the University of North Carolina's Delta flights.
