On the women's side, the top five teams remained the same, with the Emory Eagles once again garnering the top spot in the poll. The Eagles are followed by Denison, Kenyon, Johns Hopkins, and Williams in the top five.

There were a lot of changes and several new additions to the poll at this, the half-way point of the season. The biggest jump came from University of Wisconsin-La Crosse, who went from being unranked in the first poll, to earning the 16th position in this poll. New York University and University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point also went from being unranked to earning the 19th and 25th spots this time around.
